This is a great resource for personal experiences from other agencies and volunteers about the CAPRA accreditation process.

Your agency is tentatively scheduled for a site visit in **2022**. The self-assessment report must be finalized and submitted at least **ten weeks** prior to the scheduled visit. Based on your preferred visitation timeframe, your agency will be scheduled for a fall 2022 hearing to take place at the 2022 NRPA Conference.

The Commission is pleased St. Mary's County Recreation & Parks has committed to pursuing CAPRA Accreditation and hopes that participation in this program of quality assurance and improvement is of considerable value to the agency.
