April 8 Commissioner Meeting Rollup

LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their <u>business meeting</u> with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented proclamations in recognition of <u>National Animal Control & Care</u> <u>Week</u>, <u>Week of the Young Child</u>, <u>National Public Health Week</u>, and <u>National Public Safety</u> <u>Telecommunications Week</u>.

The CSMC then held a <u>public hearing</u> on the disposition of surplus county-owned real property.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- <u>Reviewed</u> future CSMC meeting agendas.
- <u>Approved</u> the modification to the Day Reporting Grant and the conversion of one full-time Case Manager position to a temporary part-time hourly Case Manager position.
- <u>Approved</u> the FY2026 Performance Incentive Grant Fund grant application.
- Approved the FY2026 Gun Violence Reduction grant application.
- Adopted the resolution waiving landfill fees for Christmas in April projects.
- <u>Approved</u> the St. Jerome's Creek Dredge Material Placement Site Construction Easement Agreement and budget amendment.
- <u>Approved</u> a letter of support for Comcast's Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD) grant application.
- <u>Approved</u> the Joint Encroachment Mitigation and Prevention Agreement with Naval Air Station Patuxent River.
- <u>Approved</u> the FY2026 Community Partnership Agreement Notice of Funding Availability Application on behalf of the Department of Aging and Human Services.
- <u>Approved</u> the FY2026 Senior Rides Grant Application.
- <u>Approved</u> the request for an increase to the FY2025 Special Events Revenue and Expenses Budget from the Department of Aging and Human Services.
- <u>Amended</u> the 2010 Comprehensive Plan Land Map to change the land use designation of the property at 25741 Three Notch Road in Hollywood, Maryland from Rural Preservation to Rural Commerce and the property's zoning district from Rural Preservation to Rural Commercial Limited.
