May 13 Commissioner Meeting Rollup

LEONARDTOWN, MD – The Commissioners of St. Mary's County (CSMC) began their business meeting with an invocation and the pledge, followed by approval of the consent agenda.

The CSMC then presented proclamations in recognition of <u>Lyme Disease Awareness Month</u>, <u>Stroke Awareness Month</u>, <u>National Skilled Nursing Care Week</u>, and <u>Older Americans Month</u>.

For their main agenda items, the commissioners took the following action:

- Repealed and replaced Ordinance 2017-30 with the proposed ordinance to designate which county roads golf carts can be legally driven on.
- Approved the request to change the land use designation of the property located at ZONE24-0040 (20698 Goddard Rd.) to Mixed-Use Medium-Intensity and zoning designation to Medium-Intensity Mixed Use.
- <u>Approved</u> the proposed revisions to the Animal Control Ordinance.

During County Administrator Time, the Commissioners took the following action:

- Reviewed future CSMC meeting agendas.
- <u>Approved</u> the request from the St. Mary's County State's Attorney's Office to convert two positions to create two Assistant State's Attorney I Positions.
- <u>Approved</u> the transfer of the County's portion of the 2025 Private Activity Bond allocation authority.
- Approved the FY2025 Hold Harmless Notice of Grant Award.
- <u>Approved</u> the budget amendment increasing the Commissioner's Emergency Reserve by \$507,866 due to salary savings.
- Approved the budget amendment increasing Highway Division snow removal accounts.

The Commissioners wrapped their business meeting with **Commissioner Time**.
