

Free National Electric Code Training

This ten hour course is designed for the individual employed in the Electrical field as an electrician. The course will cover significant changes in the National Electrical Code. Upon completion, students will be knowledgeable of significant changes in the NEC. Completion of this course will satisfy the Maryland State continuing education hours:
