INTRODUCTION

Site Location and Description

- The property is currently owned by Kelley Studio, LLC, care of Lisa Kelley, according to the current deed of the property recorded among the land records for St. Mary's County in Liber DJB 514 at Folio 439.
- This property has not been subdivided, nor were any of the property lines adjusted after December 1, 1985.
- See Appendix A for deeds and plats of record tracing the parcel history back to at least December 1, 1985 used to determine parcel of record status and critical area grandfathering status.
- The property is located on St. Mary's County Tax Map 49 Grid 1 as Parcels 71 and 247.
- These parcels contain 1.395 acres, not including any State-owned tidal wetlands.
- These parcels contain 1.395 acres within the critical area boundary according to the official critical area maps provided to us by St. Mary's County Department of Land Use & Growth Management.
- Site is located approximately 390'+\- from the nearest body of tidally influenced waters and as such no 100' or 300' Critical Area Buffer is present on site.

Proposed Development Activity

- Proposed development requires Critical Area Overlay rezoning from Rural Critical Area to Limited Development Area to allow continued use of existing commercial facilities.
- These lots are completely inside the critical area boundary.
- This is a proposed use of these parcels is commercial.
- The range of lot sizes in this subdivision is 0.999 acres to 0.396 acres.
- The average size lot in this subdivision is 0.698 acres.
- The acreage of restricted land, including the critical area buffer, for this subdivision is 0.00 acres.
- Existing lot coverage for Parcel 49 is 0 s.f.
- Existing lot coverage for Parcel 71 is 28,421 s.f.
- Proposed lot coverage for Parcel 49 is 0 s.f.
- Proposed lot coverage for Parcel 71 is 28,421 s.f.
- Stormwater management for the existing lot coverage in this development will be exempt from requirements of the 2000 Maryland Stormwater Management Design Manual using Environmental Site Design to the maximum extent practicable.
- Runoff pollution will be minimized by capturing runoff from proposed impervious areas with stormwater management infiltration practices, rainwater harvesting practices, or disconnecting impervious runoff from upstream flows allowing sediments and other pollutants to filter out.

EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

Terrestrial Resources

- The soils shown on the minor site plan were taken from the "Web Soil Survey" as prepared by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Natural Resource Conservation Service. Any highly erodible or hydric soils have been identified and shown on the plan.
- Topographic information shown on the minor subdivision preliminary plan was taken from digital maps obtained from the St. Mary's County Government, as provided by the state of Maryland, using photogrammetric and laser imaging (LIDAR) methods. Any areas of 15% slopes and greater have been identified and shown on the plan.
- The subject property shown on the minor subdivision preliminary plan appears to be located in Flood Hazard Zone X as delineated on Flood Insurance Rate Maps for St. Mary's County, Maryland, as distributed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, Community Panel Number 24037C0188E, effective date October 19, 2004.
- According to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetland Inventory maps and Maryland DNR maps, there are no wetlands on Site and none were found to be present upon Site inspection.
- The delineation of any state owned tidal wetlands, private tidal wetlands, and non-tidal wetlands was derived from Maryland DNR maps.
- Composition of the forested areas on this site is that of mixed hardwoods with a few pines on an upland site. This forest is even aged approximately 60 90 years old. Major species include: white oak, southern red oak, red maple, sweet gum, tulip poplar, American holly, black cherry, black locust, sweet gum, and virginia pine. Tulip poplar has the dominant crown position and sweet gum has the co-dominant crown position with the majority of the dominant and co-dominant trees being in the 12" 29.9" diameter at breast height size class. There are very few standing dead trees and woody debris ground cover is 20%. None of the standing dead trees were noted for wildlife activity. This stand is in the mid successional stage. Understory vegetation is moderate to heavy with 60% cover and diversity of understory species is fair with 7 major species of plants. The main species include: American holly, flowering dogwood, spice bush, red maple, sweet gum, eastern red cedar, and grape vine. Ground cover is light with 25% cover. Primary species of ground cover include: poison ivy, red maple, club moss, American holly.

POTENTIAL IMPACTS TO NATURAL RESOURCES FROM THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Terrestrial Resources and mitigation for impacts

- No clearing of existing forest is proposed as part of development.
- There is no critical area buffer on Site.
- No wetland crossings or wetland disturbances are proposed as part of development.
- No change in lot coverage is proposed as part of development.

Aquatic Resources

- Existing lot coverage is not being treated with BMPs. The existing lot coverage is exempt and grandfathered from the Stormwater Management Act of 2007. Any future lot coverage will be treated with BMPs in accordance with the 2000 Maryland Stormwater Design Manual.
- Any proposed outfall pipes, gutters, ditches, and swales shall maintain non-erosive velocities.
- No dredging or fill including pilings are proposed.

Critical Habitats

- No rare, threatened or endangered plants or wildlife listed in COMAR 08.03.08 were observed during the site visit, nor is the property or surrounding properties listed there as a Natural Heritage Area.

Cultural Features / Historic Sites

- According to the St. Mary's County Historic Site Locator Map and MERLIN maps, there are no historic sites on the property, nor were there any remnants of structures, or items indicating a historical presence found on the site.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

Shoreline Condition

- The subject property has no linear feet of water frontage.
- There are no shoreline protection methods proposed for the subject property.
- There are no mitigation proposals for the subject property.
- There are no water dependent facilities proposed for the subject property.

- Data sheets for any tidal and non-tidal wetland delineations made as part of a Wetland Evaluation Report, are not required for this submittal.

- The minor site plan for the subject property was surveyed, designed, and drafted by LSR, Inc.

AND TOGETHER WITH: (a) all of the proceeds of the voluntary or involuntary conversion of the aforementioned property or any part of the aforementioned property into cash or liquidated claims, whether by way of condemnation, insured casualty, judgment or otherwise, as well as a security interest which is hereby granted to the Lender in the same; (b) all rents, profits, and benefits, including any deposits of tenants to secure payment of the same and performance of the terms and conditions of any oral or written lease, with respect to the leasing of all or any portion of the Premises, with the right to collect such rents, profits, and benefits at any time for application to the Obligations, but without any duty or obligation to perform on behalf of the Grantor any of Grantor's duties or obligations to any lessee; (c) all revenues and profits, accounts receivables and contract rights, including any deposit of purchasers to secure payment of the contract price and performance of the terms and conditions of any contract of sale for the Premises, with the right to collect the same at any time for application to the Obligations and to utilize any collection or enforcement rights or remedies which may be available to the Grantor under law or any contract of sale, but without any duty or obligation to perform on behalf of the Grantor any of Grantor's duties or obligations of any purchaser of the Premises;

AND TOGETHER WITH: (i) an irrevocable easement to enter on and upon the Premises at any time and from to time for the purpose of making such audit tests, inspections, and examinations, including subsurface exploration and testing, as the Lender in its discretion, deems necessary, convenient, or proper to determine whether the ownership, use, and operation of the Premises and the conduct of the activities engaged in thereon are in compliance with the Environmental Requirements set forth below; (ii) the right at any time and from time to time to inspect and copy all of the Grantor's records relating to environmental matters and to enter all buildings or facilities of the Grantor for such purposes; and (iii) all of the Grantor's records with respect to environmental matters, whether or not located at the Premises or elsewhere, whether or not in possession of the Grantor or any third part, and whether written, photographic, or computerized.

All of the aforementioned Premises and other rights and benefits and all other property described in the above stated granting clauses of this Indemnity Deed of Trust are referred to as the "Secured Property". To the extent that any items of the Secured Property are not or have not yet become fixtures and permanent additions to and a part of the Premises, and are instead personal property, the Grantor grants and conveys to the Lender a continuing security interest under the Maryland Commercial Code, as amended, in all of such items of personal property and the proceeds and products thereof, as well as in all substitutions, renewals and replacements thereof and in all of such items hereafter acquired and constituting after acquired property, for so long as such items are or remain personal property and not fixtures and permanent additions to the Premises and the Grantor hereby agrees, upon the demand of Lender, to execute such financing statements or other documents necessary to evidence the Lender's security interest in said personal property.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Premises and appurtenances as aforesaid unto the Trustees and the Trustees successors and assigns, in fee simple forever IN TRUST for the benefit and security of the Lender to indemnify the Lender against loss caused by the non-payment of the Obligations and to secure the performance by the Grantor and by the Borrower of the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Loan Documents and of this Indemnity Deed of Trust, provided, however: (a) until the occurrence of a default hereunder, the Grantor may retain possession of the Premises; and (b) if the Borrower and Grantor shall pay, perform, complete and satisfy the Obligations in accordance with the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Loan Documents, then this Indemnity Deed of Trust shall cease and shall be void, and the Trustee shall release and reconvey the Premises to the Grantor and terminate this Indemnity Deed of Trust at the sole cost and expense of the Grantor.

B. Covenants of Grantor: The Grantor hereby covenants with the Lender, its successors and assigns, to do the following:

1. Repayment/Performance: The Grantor shall perform, observe, and comply with the duties, obligations, requirements, terms, conditions and provisions of, and to comply exactly in all respects with the terms, covenants, conditions, representations and warranties of the Obligations and the Loan Documents and this Indemnity Deed of Trust to be performed, observed and complied with by it. To punctually pay all indebtedness secured by this Indemnity Deed of Trust, together with interest thereon and any penalty, fee, charge,

deposit, escrow or assessment, at the times and in the manner and amounts as required by any Guaranty signed by the Grantor.

- 2. Taxes and Expense. The Grantor shall pay and discharge, when and as the same come due, all taxes of every kind and nature, real and personal; all general and special assessments and levies; all water, sewer and other utility charges, rents and assessments; and any and all other public charges, dues, levies, impositions, or assessments of a like or different nature, imposed upon or assessed against the Secured Property or the rents, issues, income or profits thereof, and which are or may become liens against the same, as well as any ground rent to which the Real Property may be subject, and the Grantor shall not permit to exist any lien or security interest for taxes, assessments, levies, fees, ground rents and public charges, except for those liens and security interests to which the Lender has specifically and in writing consented and with respect to which the Grantor has paid currently all sums secured thereby. The Grantor shall, upon the request of the Trustees or the Lender, deliver to the Trustees or the Lender receipts evidencing the payment of all such taxes, assessments, levies, fees, rents, ground rents, and public charges imposed upon or assessed against the Secured Property, or the revenues, rents, issues, income, or profits thereof, as well as the payment of all superior liens and security interests with respect to which the Lender may have consented.
- 3. Condition and Use of Improvements. The Grantor shall keep the Premises in good condition and operating order and repair and to not abandon, commit waste, remove, demolish or materially alter all or any part of the Premises, or make any change in the use of the Secured Property which would in any way increase any ordinary fire or other hazard insurance risk, or remove any personalty therefrom, without the prior written consent of the Lender, which consent may be withheld by the Lender in its absolute subjective discretion.
- 4. Inspections: The Grantor shall permit the Trustees or the Lender, or their agents or employees, at all reasonable times to enter and inspect the Secured Property. To permit representatives of the Lender to inspect the Premises from time to time at any reasonable time.
- 5. *Title.* The Grantor, as of the date hereof has, and at all times during the terms of this Indemnity Deed of Trust shall maintain and keep, good and marketable title to the Secured Property free and clear of any and all liens, charges, restrictions, encumbrances, security interests and adverse claims whatsoever, except as otherwise expressly consented to in writing by the Lender.
- 6. Statutes, Ordinances, Rules. The Grantor shall not violate any statutes, rules, laws, regulations, or ordinances applicable to the Secured property or any use thereof and the Grantor shall, in its use and operation of the Secured Property, comply fully and strictly with all said laws, rules and regulations of any federal, state and local governmental authority having jurisdiction over the Secured Property, including but not limited to all zoning, land use and environmental laws, rules and regulations. The Grantor shall comply fully and strictly with all restrictions, covenants, easements, setbacks and other limitations on the use of the Secured property.
- 7. Condemnation. The Grantor shall notify the Trustees and Lender immediately upon obtaining knowledge of the institution of any proceeding for condemnation of all or any portion of the Secured Property; and shall cooperate with and permit the Lender to participate in the same; and to apply to the unpaid Obligations as the Lender may direct any award or proceeds of any condemnation or eminent domain proceeding pertaining to all or any part of the Secured Property. The Grantor shall execute all instruments requested of Grantor to request such participation and to allow the payment of such condemnation awards to the Lender.
- 8. Insurance. To keep the Premises fully insured with a responsible insurance company approved by the Lender for the benefit of the Lender against loss by fire, flood, or other hazards and casualties and to obtain and maintain liability insurance, in such amounts, with such insurance companies and upon policy forms acceptable to and approved by Lender as may be specified by the Lender from time to time and to deliver to the Lender the insurance policy, certificate thereof, and/or paid receipts evidencing the existence of said policy, and the payment of all premiums.
- 9. Escrows: The Lender, at any time or from time to time, upon notice to Grantor, may require the deposit by the Grantor with the Lender, of an amount sufficient to discharge the obligations of the Grantor for the payment of taxes, assessments, levies, fees, rents, and other public charges imposed upon or assessed against the Secured Property or the revenues, rents, issues, income or profits thereof or the payment of the premiums for any insurance required by this Indemnity Deed of Trust. Any said sums shall be paid within ten (10) days of the request of the Lender.
- 10. Future Advances. The Lender may make future advances to the Borrower and/or the Grantor and may advance or re-advance funds to the Borrower or Grantor and all such future advances or re-advances shall be fully secured by the lien and security interest of this Indemnity Deed of Trust.
- 11. Confirmation. The Grantor shall take such further actions as the Lender may at any time reasonably request for the better assuring and confirming to the Lender the Secured Property, this Indemnity Deed of Trust and/or the conveyance and lien created hereby.
- 12. Preservation of Lien. The Grantor shall take all steps and do all things necessary, convenient, or proper to establish, protect, preserve, and maintain the priority and status of the lien and security interest in the Secured Property established and intended to be established by this Indemnity Deed of Trust, except and only to the extent the Lender may have consented specifically and in writing to a senior lien or security interest.
- 13. Cost of Enforcement. To pay when due and payable any and all costs, expenses, recordation taxes and other taxes for which the Premises, the Lender and/or the Grantor may at any time be liable in connection with or as a result of the maturity, collection, enforcement, recording or foreclosure of the Obligation, of any of the Loan Documents or of this Indemnity Deed of Trust.
- 14. Environmental Requirements. The Grantor represents and warrants to the Trustees and the Lender that no materials or substances previously have been or are now located in, on or near the Secured Property, which, under federal, state, or local law, statute, ordinance or regulation, or court or administrative order or decree, or private agreement (collectively "Environmental Requirements", require special handling in collection, storage, treatment, or disposal. The Grantor shall not place or permit to be placed any such

materials or substances in, on or near the Secured Property, and all leases affecting the Secured property shall contain a covenant to that effect. If at any time it is determined that there are materials or substances located in, on or near the Secured property, which, under any Environmental Requirement, require special handling in collection, storage, treatment, or disposal, the Grantor shall immediately commence or cause to be commenced and diligently pursued to completion within thirty days thereafter, or such earlier time as required by any Environmental Requirement at Grantor's sole expense such actions as may be necessary to comply with all Environmental Requirements. If the Grantor fails to take any such action, the Lender may make advances or payments toward performance or satisfaction of the same but shall be under no obligation so to do, and all sums so advanced or paid, including all sums advanced or paid in connection with any judicial or administrative investigation of proceeding relating thereto, including without limitation reasonable attorney's fees, and fines or other penalty payments, shall be at once repayable by the Grantor and shall bear interest at the default rate provided in the Promissory Note, from the date the same shall become due and payable until the date paid, and all sums so advanced or paid, with interest as aforesaid shall become a part of the Obligations. The Grantor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Trustees and the Lender from all loss, liability, damage, cost and expense, including attorney's fees, for failure of the Secured Property to comply in all respects with all Environmental Requirements. The provisions of this Section shall survive payoff, release, or foreclosure of this Indemnity Deed of Trust. The Grantor, promptly upon the written request of the Lender from time to time, shall, at Grantor's expense, provide the Lender with an environmental site assessment or report, all in scope, form, and content satisfactory to the Lender. The Lender, or its designated agents, may interview any or all of the Grantor's agents and employees regarding environmental matters, including any consultants or experts retained by the Grantor, all of whom are directed to discuss environmental issued fully and openly with the Lender or its designated agents and to provide such information as may be requested. All of the costs and expenses incurred by the Lender with respect to the audits, tests, inspections, and examinations which the Lender may conduct, including the fees of engineers, laboratories, and contractors, shall be paid by Grantor. The Grantor shall remain liable hereunder regardless of any other provisions hereof which may limit Grantor's liability.

- 15. Assignments of Rents. The Grantor assigns to the Lender all leases and rents of the Secured Property, independent of whether a receiver is appointed or not, or any part thereof, now existing or which may be executed at any time in the future prior to the expiration or termination of this Deed of Trust and all amendments, extensions and renewals thereof (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Leases" or singularly as a "Lease") together with any and all guarantees of the obligations of the lessees under said Leases, (hereinafter such lessees are collectively referred to as the "Lessees" or singularly as a "Lessee"), and all rents, income and profits which may now or hereafter be or become due or owing under the Leases, or any of them, or on account of the use and/or occupancy of the Secured Property provided, however that nothing herein shall obligate the Lender to perform any of the Grantor's duties or obligations under any lease or shall entitle any lease to continue in full force and effect after a foreclosure sale unless the Lender has affirmatively elected to make the foreclosure sale subject to the lease. The rights assigned hereunder shall include all of the Grantor's right and power to modify any Lease, to terminate the term, to accept a surrender thereof, to waive or release the Lessee thereunder from the performance or observance by such Lessee of any obligation or condition thereof, and to anticipate rents thereunder for more than one (1) month prior to accrual.
- 15.1 Grantor represents that Grantor is the sole and exclusive owner and possessor of the lessor's interest in the Leases. Grantor has not and will not make or execute any other assignment of any of the Leases, or the rents, income and profits accruing from the Secured Property. Grantor has not and will not perform any acts or omit to do any acts, or execute any other instruments, which will or might prevent Lender from fully exercising Lender's rights under any of the terms, covenants and conditions of this Assignment.
- 15.2 The Grantor shall perform all of Grantor's obligations under any such Leases and shall take any and all steps which may be required to preserve and maintain the liability of any tenant under any such Leases. Grantor represents and warrants that: (i) all Leases now existing have been heretofore delivered to Lender for approval by Lender; (ii) all such Leases are valid and enforceable in accordance with their terms (subject only to applicable bankruptcy and insolvency laws) and there are no material defaults now existing under any of such Leases and no state of facts now exists which, with the giving of notice or the lapse of time, or both, would constitute a material default or event of default except as heretofore disclosed to Lender in writing; (iii) such Leases have not been altered, modified, amended, terminated or renewed, nor have any of the terms and conditions thereof been waived in any manner, except as heretofore disclosed to Lender in writing; (iv) no such Lease will be hereafter altered, modified, or amended in any material respect, or terminated or renewed, nor will any material term or condition thereof by the Lessees to be kept, observed or performed be waived, nor will the Lessees be released from the observance or performance of any duties or obligations thereunder, without the prior written approval of Lender; and (iv) all Leases hereafter entered into shall be in such form, with such Lessees, and under such terms and conditions as shall have been previously approved by Lender. Following approval by Lender, no such Lease will be altered, modified, or amended in any material respect, or terminated or renewed, nor will any material term or condition thereof by the Lessees to be kept, observed or performed be waived, nor will the Lessee be released from the observance and performance of any duties or obligations thereunder, without the prior written approval of Lender.
- 15.3 Grantor will keep, observe and perform each and every condition and covenant of the Leases by Grantor to be kept, observed or performed. Grantor will give prompt notice to Lender of any material default under any Lease. Grantor, at its sole cost and expense, will enforce, short of termination, the performance and observance of each and every covenant and condition of each Lease by the Lessee thereunder to be kept, observed and performed. Grantor, at its sole cost and expense, will appear in and defend any and all actions growing out of, or in any manner related to, any of the Leases or the obligations, rights, or liabilities of Grantor or any of the Lessees thereunder.
- 15.4 Grantor has not and will not collect, or accept payment of, rent under any of the Leases for more than one (1) month in advance. So long as there shall exist no Event of Default, as hereinafter defined, on the part of Grantor, the Grantor shall have the right to

collect, but not more than one (1) month prior to accrual, all rents, issues and profits and to retain, use and enjoy the same.

- 15.5 If an Event of Default occurs, Lender may at Lender's option, without notice to Grantor, in addition to any other remedies available to it, do any one or more of the following: (i) enter upon, take possession of, lease and operate the Secured Property, without becoming a mortgagee in possession; take possession of all personal property, fixtures, documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Grantor relating thereto, and exclude the Grantor, its agents and servants, therefrom; (ii) perform any and all obligations of Grantor under any of the Leases, and exercise any and all rights of Grantor therein contained, as fully as Grantor could, without regard to the adequacy of security for the indebtedness hereby secured, with or without the bringing of any legal action or the causing of any receiver to be appointed by any court; (iii) make, enforce, modify and accept the surrender of any Lease; (iv) retain and/or evict any Lessee; (v) fix or modify rent with respect to all or any portion of the Secured Property; (vi) sue for or otherwise collect and receive all rents, issues and profits with respect to all or any portion of the Secured Property; and (vii) do all other acts which Lender may deem necessary or proper to protect Lender's security.
- Grantor's name and/or in Lender's name, after an Event of Default hereunder, to sue for or make such settlement of claims as Lender may deem necessary or desirable, or otherwise demand, collect and receive, all rents, issues and profits emanating from or related to the Secured Property, or any part thereof, or any of the Leases, and to apply the same: first, to and against all costs and expenses of operation of the Secured Property (including, but not limited to, the payment of taxes, special assessments, insurance premiums, damage claims, and costs of maintaining, repairing, rebuilding and restoring the improvements on the Secured Property) or of making the same rentable, of the performance of Grantor's obligations under the Leases, and of collection (including reasonable attorneys' fees) of such rents, issues and profits; second, to interest on, and then to the principal of, the indebtedness secured hereby; and third, to any other indebtedness or charge secured hereby. This power of attorney shall be deemed to be coupled with an interest, shall be irrevocable, and shall not terminate on the disability of the Grantor. It is the intention of Grantor that all persons and parties may rely upon this power of attorney, and continue to rely upon it.
- 15.7 The Lessees are authorized and directed upon written demand by Lender to pay any and all amounts due to Grantor under or pursuant to the Leases to Lender, or to such nominee as Lender may designate in writing delivered to and received by such Lessees. The Lessees are hereby expressly relieved of any and all duty, liability or obligation to Grantor in respect of all payments so made.
- 15.8 Lender shall be under no obligation to exercise or prosecute any of the rights or claims assigned to Lender hereunder, or to perform or carry out any of the obligations of Grantor under any of the Leases, and Lender does not assume any liabilities in connection with or arising or growing out of the covenants and agreements of Grantor in the Leases. This Assignment shall not operate to place responsibility for the control, care, management or repair of the Secured Property, or any part thereof, upon Lender, nor shall it operate to make Lender liable for the performance of any of the terms and conditions of any of the Leases, or for any waste of the Secured Property by the Lessees or by any other party, or for any dangerous or defective condition of the Secured Property, or for any negligence in the management, upkeep, repair or control of the Secured Property, resulting in loss, injury or death of any of the Lessees, or to any other person or party.
- 15.9 Grantor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold Lender harmless from any and all liability, loss, damage, cost or expense, including reasonable attorneys' fees, which may be incurred by Lender under any of the Leases, or by reason of this Assignment, and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against Lender by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on Lender's part to perform or discharge any of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in any of the Leases, other than any liability, loss, damage, claim or demand arising solely from willful misconduct of Lender.
- 16. Advancements: If the Grantor fails to perform, comply with or observe any of the covenants set forth above, or to protect or preserve the Indemnity Deed of Trust or the status and priority of the lien and security interest of this Indemnity Deed of Trust, then at the option of the Lender, the Grantor may be deemed in default of this Indemnity Deed of Trust, and in addition to any other remedies set forth in this instrument, or available at law or in equity, the Lender may, in its absolute subjective discretion, perform or observe any of the aforesaid obligations and make advances to perform the same on behalf of Grantor, and all monies advanced and/or costs and expenses incurred by the Lender in so doing (hereinafter referred to as the "Expense Payments"), together with interest thereon at a per annum rate of interest which is equal to the highest rate of interest charged on any of the Obligations plus one percent (1%) per annum, from the date of payment until repaid to the Lender in full, shall be paid to the Lender by the Grantor on demand and shall immediately upon advancement become a lien and security interest upon the Premises and shall be secured by this Indemnity Deed of Trust. The contrary notwithstanding, the authorization in this paragraph shall impose no duty or obligation on the Lender to perform any action or make any advancement on behalf of the Grantor and is for the sole benefit and protection of the Lender.
- C. Escrows: The Lender, at any time or from time to time, may require the deposit by the Grantor with the Lender of an amount sufficient to discharge the obligations of the Grantor, when they come due for: (a) the payment of taxes, assessments, levies, fees, rent and other public charges imposed upon or assessed against the Premises; or (b) the payment of the premiums for fire, casualty, and other hazard and flood insurance. The determination of the amount so payable and of the fractional part thereof to be deposited with Lender, so that the aggregate of such deposits shall be sufficient to assure the payment of the aforesaid expenses when and as they come due, shall be made by the Lender in its sole and absolute discretion. If the Lender determines prior to the due date of any of the aforementioned obligations that the amount then on deposit shall be insufficient for the payment of such obligation in full, the Grantor, within ten (10) calendar days after demand, shall deposit the amount of the deficiency with the Lender. The contrary notwithstanding the Lender shall

retain the right under the provisions of this Indemnity Deed of Trust to pay any such amount and to add the amount so paid together with interest as set forth in this Indemnity Deed of Trust for other advances.

- D. Consents of Grantor: Without notice to and further consent of the Grantor, and without in any way waiving or releasing this Indemnity Deed of Trust or any of its provisions, the Grantor hereby consents to:
  - 1. Any extension of time for payment of all or any part of the Obligations granted to the Borrower by the Lender;
  - 2. Any renewal, modification, waiver, or release of all or any part of the Obligation;
- 3. The addition to or release of any maker, accommodation maker, endorser, guarantor, surety, or indemnitor of all or any part of the collateral and security for any of the Loan Documents or for all or any part of the Obligations;
- 4. Any indulgence and/or waiver given to the Borrower or any accommodation maker, endorser, guarantor, surety, or indemnitor of all or any given part of the Obligations;
- 5. The Lender making future advances to Borrower and/or advancing or readvancing funds to the Borrower, with all such future advances and readvances being fully secured by the lien and security interest of this Indemnity Deed of Trust.
- E. Events of Default: The occurrence of any one or more of the following events shall constitute a default under this Indemnity Deed of Trust (hereinafter referred to as "Events of Default"):
- 1. Failure to Pay: The failure to pay the Obligations or any other obligations created by any of the Loan Documents as when due and payable.
- 2. Failure to Perform or Default: The failure of any person to perform, observe or comply with any of the terms, conditions, covenants, agreements, and/or provisions of this Indemnity Deed of Trust or any of the Obligations. The occurrence of a default under any of the Loan Documents or a default under any document or instrument creating a lien or security interest in the Secured Property, whether senior, junior or of equal priority to the lien and security interest of this Indemnity Deed of Trust.
- 3. Failure to Perform Under Guaranty. The failure of any person to perform or observe any of the terms, covenants, conditions, and provisions of any Guaranty executed in connection with loan to the Borrower, included the Guaranty of the Grantor or any other person in connection with the loan.
- 4. Disposition of Secured Property. The transfer, encumbrance or conveyance of all or any part of the Secured property without the prior written consent of the Lender.
- 5. Misleading Information. If any of the information contained in any financial statement, application, schedule, report, or any other document given by the Grantor, by the Borrower, Guarantor or any other person in connection with the Obligation or with any of the Loan Documents is not in all respects true, correct and accurate, or if the Grantor, Borrower or such other person omitted or failed to state any material fact or any fact necessary to make such information not misleading.
- 6. Bankruptcy. The filing of any petition, voluntary or involuntary, under the Bankruptcy Code or any similar Federal or State statute, or the taking possession by a receiver, liquidator, assignee, trustee, custodian or similar official, by or against the Grantor or Borrower, or the property of the Grantor, Borrower or Guarantor.
- 7. Dissolution. The dissolution, merger, consolidation, reorganization or death, as applicable, of the Grantor, Borrower or Guarantor.
- 8. Cross Default. A default under any obligation or indebtedness owed by the Grantor, Borrower or any Guarantor of the Loan, regardless or when created or whether secured or unsecured.
- F. Remedies Upon Default: Upon the occurrence of a default under this Indemnity Deed of Trust, the Trustees or Lender may, in their sole and absolute discretion and option, accelerate and declare immediately due and payable all Obligations and/or exercise any other rights available to them and/or proceed to enforce this Indemnity Deed of Trust and in connection with such enforcement by the Lender, the Grantor does hereby agree as follows:
- 1. Foreclosure, Assent to Decree and Power of sale. In the event the Trustees or the Lender elect to institute foreclosure proceedings upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, the Grantor assents to the passage of a decree for the sale of the Secured Property and further authorizes the Trustees to sell the Secured Property. Any sale of the Secured Property, whether by way of the assent to decree or power of sale shall be made in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Real Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland and with the Maryland Rules of Procedure, including by way of example, Md. Real Prop. Code Ann. § 7-105 et seq. and Md. Rules W-70 and W-77, and any amendments or supplements thereto, or other applicable general or local laws of the State of Maryland or judicial rules of procedure relating to foreclosure of deeds of trust. Such sale may be of the entire premises as a unit or of such parts or parcels of the entire premises, as the Lender or Trustees, in their sole and absolute discretion, deems necessary, proper, or convenient. 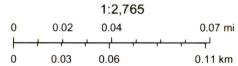

1972 WETLANDS MAP



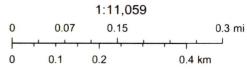

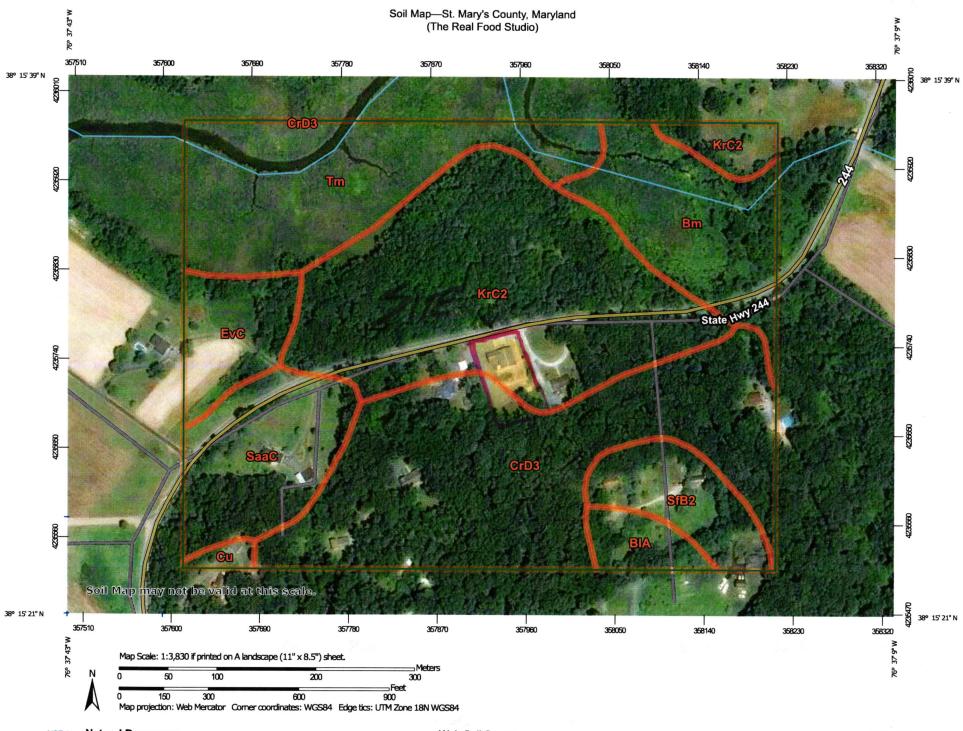
