





Mission Statement

The St. Mary's County Museum Division was instituted by the St. Mary's County Board of County Commissioners to collect, preserve, research and interpret the historic sites and artifacts that illustrate the natural and cultural histories of St. Clement's Island and the Potomac River, the Piney Point Lighthouse and the Chesapeake Bay, and the Drayden African American and Charlotte Hall schoolhouses.

With this as its charter, the Museum Division serves as a resource, liaison and community advocate for all St. Mary's County public and private cultural assets.

Overview of Facilities

The St. Mary's County Museum Division manages 94 acres of property and 4 historic sites, including: St. Clement's Island Museum and the Charlotte Hall Schoolhouse; the Piney Point Lighthouse, Museum and Historic Park; the Drayden African American Schoolhouse; and the U-1105 Underwater Submarine Shipwreck Preserve near Piney Point Park. The Museum Division also assists with the monitoring and maintenance of St. Clement's Island State Park.

Also in the Museum Division's care are:

- 6 historic buildings including the Piney Point Lighthouse; Piney Point Lighthouse Keepers' Quarters; the Piney Point Lighthouse Fuel Building; the 1943 U.S. Navy Workshop Building; the Drayden African American Schoolhouse; and the Charlotte Hall Schoolhouse
- 7 contemporary support buildings; 4 public piers; a kayak launch; an outreach van, staff car, and a water taxi.

2012 Restoration Work Completed

- Drayden Schoolhouse floor was leveled and damaged foundation supports replaced.
- The 1933 Steuart Petroleum oil delivery truck was moved from the exterior storage compound at St. Clement's Island Museum to a secure indoor storage facility provided by the Parks Division.
- Exterior exhibits including an apple cider press; tobacco planter and oyster tongs were wrapped for decontamination and prepared for indoor storage in the collections management facility.
- Project plans were developed and submitted to the county procurement office to prepare a bid package for the restoration work on the Piney Point lighthouse tower and keeper's quarters.
- A boat cradle was built and installed to support the Joy Parks push boat exhibit in the Potomac River Maritime Exhibit Building.

2012 Capital Improvements

- Completed and closed out the MHAA 2007, MHAA 2008, and the Program Open Space 2008 grants used for the Piney Point Museum and Park Enhancement Project.
- Repairs were completed on the Piney Point boardwalk, damaged by Hurricane Irene
- Completed and installed 2 new interpretive panels for St. Clement's Island State Park.
- Completed and installed 4 new interpretive panels for Piney Point Lighthouse, Museum and Historic Park.
- Cleaned and reconfigured the St. Clement's Island Museum outdoor storage compound.
- Painted and refurbished the St. Clement's Island Museum multi-purpose room to be utilized for rotating and temporary exhibits.
- Completed the Coast Guard mandated incline test and the insurance-required report of condition and value for the water taxi.
