SUBJECT: Analysis of Bias Based Profiling - 2023

The following is an analysis for Bias Based Profiling by deputy sheriffs of the St. Mary's County Sheriff's Office during the periods of January through December 2023. The Sheriff's Office has an administrative policy regarding Traffic Enforcement specifically covering policies prohibiting Biased Based Traffic Stops which can be found in SMCSO Policy 401.1 Bias Based Policing. In accordance with Section 25-113 of the Maryland Transportation Article, the Sheriff's Office has gathered since 2002 specific data elements on Motor Vehicle Stops for entry into Delta Plus to generate statistical reports to the State of Maryland. Data for this report was derived from the Delta Plus software maintained by the Maryland State Police.

In 2023, the Sheriff's Office reported a total of 13,617 traffic stops. Of those, 4,180 traffic stops met the criteria for captured stops. The criteria refers to traffic stops which are based on the deputies' own observations as a reason for the stop and are cleared as "X1" by the deputies. This report does not include traffic stop data originating from the following:

- Radar Enforcement
- LASER Enforcement
- License Plate Readers (LPRs)
- Motor Vehicle Accidents
- Criminal Investigations
- Suspicious Activity

The Sheriff's Office conducted a traffic enforcement initiative between August and October of 2023 called "Slow Down St. Mary's". The initiative addressed speeding, distracted driving, reckless driving, and other violations. There were seven (7) deputies and one (1) supervisor assigned to the initiative. As a result of the increased traffic enforcement there was a substantial increase in the total number of traffic stops from 9,380 in 2022 to 13,617 in 2023. There were a total of 3,393 traffic stops during this initiative.


