

2020: A YEAR OF CHAL **2020 was a year like no other, to say the least.** A deadly pandemic swept the globe, shuttering businesses and quarantining many. Yet we survived, and in many ways actually thrived. The temporary closures of the sites pushed us to explore new ideas and to become more creative and adaptive in all we did. We adapted schedules to maximize the safety of our staff and **visitors.** Administrative staff (five full-time employees and two part-time (Friends) employees teleworked from March through May, and then began coming in one day a week in June. After about six weeks, the staff began coming in more regularly as the sites were opened. Flexibility was key as the situation evolved. Museum assistants were laid off in March and the water taxi captains were not hired for the season, which normally opens March 25th. All were brought back in June when we began running the water taxi. With the addition of the Old Jail Museum in June, we needed to hire several new museum assistants in addition to bringing back all those already on the books. We reopened sites gradually and safely. The St. Clement's Island Museum reopened in September, and Piney Point followed in November, just in time for the annual Holiday Open Houses and exhibits. Piney Point while we were closed to the public, including: • installing new flooring on the first floor of the main museum building

We used down time for upgrades! We made some exciting changes at

- installing three new permanent exhibits in the main museum building
- completing the installation of a new temporary exhibit in the main museum building
- installing new interpretive panels in the Keeper's Quarters

- Changing *Throwback Thursday* to a *From Our Collections* presentation of interesting and unusual items from the collections



- It served as the host site for a Business After Hours event for the Chamber of Commerce and has been open for all of Leonardtown's First Friday events

Thank you for staying with us and continuing to support the Museum Division.










Museum Division Board of Trustees
