St. Mary's 2050: Charting Our Tomorrow Community Engagement Window #2 Report

INTRODUCTION

As part of Phase 3 of St. Mary's 2050, all members of the community were invited to participate in **Community Engagement Window #2** (CEW #2). Beginning on May 16 and continuing through the end of June, residents, property and business owners, and community partners had the opportunity to share their thoughts and provide feedback on ideas for the future of St. Mary's County by taking three brief surveys. The surveys were available for completion online and administered in-person at **15** community-hosted events such as the Southern Maryland Heritage Festival at Historic Sotterley and the Community, Culture & Cuisine event held in Lexington Park. This Report shares all responses that were provided.

A total of 1,380 community members participated in CEW #2.*










4. Which of the following should be prioritized for future long-term investment? Please select your top two choices.



2. Which of the following best describes where you live? Answer Choices (select one)






