## Rules for Participation

The Department of Aging & Human Services is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for senior activity center consumers, volunteers, instructors, and staff. To ensure this supportive environment, the following Rules of Participation has been established:

- 1.Be respectful toward all consumers, staff, instructors, and volunteers. Bullying, profanity, harassment, or threatening behavior will not be tolerated. Additionally, the use of intimidating or derogatory comments, slurs, or language that is abusive, excessively loud, insulting, or demeaning will not be tolerated.
- 2.Act in an orderly and cooperative manner. Disruptive or disrespectful behavior toward other consumers, instructors, staff, or volunteers is prohibited.
- 3. Engage in activities in a manner that promotes inclusivity and cooperation. Be mindful of others' enjoyment and participation in center activities.
- 4. Ensure a safe environment by practicing caution and care. Report any hazards or unsafe conditions to staff immediately.
- 5. Follow all posted rules for activities and building use. Programs and senior activity center amenities or spaces may have additional guidelines that must be followed when engaging in these programs or services.
- 6.**Respect the property of the center and others.** Theft, damage, or misuse of property is grounds for immediate dismissal.
- 7. Maintain a clean and well-groomed personal appearance. Attire must be appropriate for a community setting.
- 8. Smoking and use of alcohol or illegal drugs on the premises is not permitted. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will be asked to leave the center.
- 9. No personal care activities shall take place on the premises.
- 10.No weapons are allowed on the premises.
- 11. No solicitation is allowed.
- 12.**No pets allowed.** Comfort or emotional support animals are not allowed. Service animals who are trained to do work or perform a task for persons with disabilities are permitted.

Violations of these rules may result in suspension from the center(s), revocation of center privileges, and the involvement of law enforcement.
