Attendance averages about 4,000.

For over 40 years, the department has provided high quality arts and entrainment through theatrical arts and music. The Summerstock production provides 50-100 children up to age 21 years each summer the opportunity to perform a high quality production for the community. Thanks in large part to a core group of volunteers, the show provides citizens of all ages exposure to the arts.

Event Details

The "off-broadway" caliber of talent is displayed each summer, showcases 8 showtimes the last two full weekends of July. With a capacity of 700 ticket holders per show, this event brings to life so many wonderful productions from children themed to many of the well-known, classic theater productions. Previous shows range from Music Man to Wizard of Oz.

Total attendance averages between 3,200-4,800 ticket sales.
