Captain of St. Mary's County passenger vessel; performs other duties as assigned.

### Essential Functions

1. Operates vessel in accordance with all rules and safety requirements of the United States Coast Guard as they pertain to the safe operation of a passenger vessel;
2. Supervises other personnel when assigned;
3. Oversees boat upkeep and maintenance; including supervising scheduled maintenance of engine, emergency equipment and first aid kit, appearance, and a structural inspection of the vessel before each trip;
4. Participates in all United States Coast Guard inspections and emergency drills on an annual basis;
5. Responsible for the location and safe keeping of all documents pertaining to the operation of the tour vessel.;
6. Reports to the St. Clement's Island Museum Site Supervisor problems, concerns, maintenance requests, and incidence Reports pertaining to the operation of the tour vessel;
7. Ensures licenses, and inspection certificates are current and in force;
8. Performs other duties as assigned.
