

Director's Note P. Wade Thompson



Leading up to auditions, and during the rehearsal process, I had many people say something like this to me, "TARZAN"? I didn't even know there was a stage version? Oh, the Disney movie?" Brooks Whiteford, our sound and lighting guru, has been begging us to do TARZAN® since he was involved in a production in Baltimore 10 or so years ago.

I loved Disney's animated TARZAN®! If memory serves, back in 1999, the movie soundtrack was released a few weeks before the movie. I've always been a sucker for a good movie soundtrack. I made one of my roommates seriously mad at me by buying the TARZAN® soundtrack the day it was released, before he knew it was out. He was a huge Phil Collins fan and couldn't accept that I had the album - and had listened to it - before he did.

I did not get to see TARZAN® on Broadway during its brief run (first preview on March 24, 2006 to closing night on July 8, 2007), but the fact that Disney turned their animated TARZAN® movie into a stage musical intrigued me. The characters in the movie don't actually sing the songs. I just didn't know how that was going to work.

Sometimes when I'm preparing to direct a show, I will avoid all opportunities to see other productions of the show, and sometimes I just need to see someone else's interpretation of a show to find my way into it. A couple of weeks before we started rehearsals, I drove to Virginia to see a high school production. It was a great production and I got a lot of inspiration from it. We actually bought a lot of the crates and soft goods (rope vines, fabric drops, etc.) you see onstage from that high school.

I love trying new things! One of my mantras is that when someone says, "we've never done it that way before," it's time to change!

Sometimes those changes are dictated by outside forces. Summerstock has never been performed at Chopticon before. Great Mills was unavailable to us this year because they are doing some MUCH needed repair/replacement work to their HVAC system. Anyone who used one of the blankets we had available last year for Cinderella understands.

We've never used metal trusses for our set before! As I write this, we haven't even started rehearsing with them yet! They're being delivered a week from today! I hope they work out and enable us to do the things I want to accomplish. You'll find out tonight!

Summerstock would not be possible were it not for R&P staff, the Summerstock team of paid and volunteer staff, sponsors, parent volunteers, our dedicated live orchestra, and our incredibly talented Southern Maryland youth who chose to spend their summer with us so we could all put on a great show together! Thanks for supporting us by coming to see the show and encouraging your friends and family to do the same!

Phil Collins (Music and Lyrics)

Phil Collins' ascent to the status of one of the most successful pop and adult contemporary singers of the '80s and beyond was probably as much a surprise to him as it was to many others. Balding and diminutive, the Genesis drummer-turned-vocalist was almost 30 years old when his first solo single, "In the Air Tonight," became a number two hit in his native U.K. (the song was a Top 20 hit in the U.S.). Between 1984 and 1990, Collins had a string of 13 straight U.S. Top Ten hits.

Long before any of that happened, however, Collins was a child actor/singer who appeared as the Artful Dodger in the London production of *Oliver!* in 1964. (He also has a cameo in A *Hard Day's Night*, among other films.) He got his first break in music in his late teens, when he was chosen to be a replacement drummer in the British art rock band Genesis in 1970. (Collins maintained a separate jazz career with the band Brand X as well.)

Genesis was fronted by singer Peter Gabriel. They had achieved a moderate level of success in the U.K. and the U.S. with elaborate concept albums, before Gabriel abruptly left in 1974. Genesis auditioned 400 singers without success, then decided to let Collins have a go. The result was a gradual simplifying of Genesis' sound and an increasing focus on Collins' expressive, throaty voice. And Then There Were Three... went gold in 1978, and Duke was even more successful.

Collins made his debut solo album, Face Value, in 1981, which turned out to be a bigger hit than any Genesis album. It concentrated on Collins' voice, often in stark, haunting contexts such as the piano-and-drum dirge "In the Air Tonight," which sounded like something from John Lennon's debut solo album, John Lennon/Plastic Ono Band.

During the '80s, Collins was enormously successful in balancing his continuing solo work with his membership in Genesis. In 1992, Genesis released We Can't Dance and began an extensive tour. Upon its completion, Collins released Both Sides in 1993, and the record became his first album not to produce a major hit single or go multi-platinum. In 1995, he announced that he was leaving Genesis permanently.

The following year, he released Dance Into the Light. Although the album didn't chart highly, its subsequent supporting tour was a success. The Hits collection followed in 1998, and a year later Collins made his first big-band record, Hot Night in Paris. The song cycle Testify arrived in 2002, and his next studio-recorded solo release was 2010's Going Back, which saw him revisiting the Motown hits that so influenced him and featured three of the surviving Funk Brothers -- guitarists Eddie Willis and Ray Monette, and bassist Bob Babbitt.

After some time spent out of the spotlight, much of it spent recovering from physical ailments, Collins returned in 2014 to play a couple of songs at his sons' school and to write songs with Adele. Soon after he began work on reissuing his solo albums, sorting through the archives for demos and live recordings to flesh them out. Beginning in early 2016, Warner Music Group began releasing the discs in pairs, with new portraits of Collins on the covers in place of the original images. While rumors of autobiographies and world tours swirled, Collins did actually return to the stage in March of 2016, performing at Little Dreams Foundation Benefit Gala in Miami.

David Henry Hwang

David Henry Hwang's stage works includes the plays M. Butterfly, Yellow Face, Chinglish, Kung Fu, Golden Child, The Dance and the Railroad, and FOB, as well as the Broadway musicals Elton John & Tim Rice's Aida (co-author), Flower Drum Song (2002 revival) and Disney's TARZAN. Hwang is a Tony Award winner and three-time nominee, a three-time OBIE Award winner, a Grammy Award winner who has been twice nominated, and a three-time Finalist for the Pulitzer Prize in Drama. Opera News called him America's most-produced living opera librettist. He co-wrote the Gold Record "Solo" with the late pop icon Prince and was a Writer/Consulting Producer for the Golden Globe-winning television series The Affair from 2015-2019. Hwang is currently creating Empress, a TV series for Netflix; the live-action musical feature film The Hunchback of Notre Dame for Disney Studios; and a movie to star actress Gemma Chan. Hwang serves as Head of Playwriting at Columbia University School of the Arts and sits on the Board of the American Theatre Wing, where he recently completed his term as Chair. His newest work, Soft Power, a collaboration with composer Jeanine Tesori, premiered at Los Angeles' Ahmanson Theatre, where it won six Ovation Awards. Its subsequent run at the Public Theatre in NYC received a 2020 Grammy nomination for Best Musical Theatre Album and was a Finalist for the 2020 Pulitzer Prize in Drama.


