Minutes of last meeting read and adopted.

In the matter of the Dan Russell family spoken of as in need of help at the meeting of Jan 8th. 1935, Mr. Harvey Bailey reports having taken the matter up with Father S. John Rudtke, and an effort is being made to place the children in private families of the 7th Dist.

Mr. Kloter addressed the Board, requesting that the Cobruns Wharf road be taken over by the County and repaired. Mr. Kloter was advised by the Board to have Deed and Survey made, conveying the Right of Way to the County, and agreed to accept same, and recommend the improvement of the road.

Mr. J.A. Watts came before the Board and requested an increase in his pension. The Board refused to grant the increase.

Letter from the State Tax Commission, advising that Mrs Mary P. Davidson, would make an appeal against the assessment made by the County Commissioners on her property, in this County.

Jan. 23rd. 1935, at 2.P.M. was the time set for the hearing, and Mr. Aloysius F. King, and Mr. J. Franklin Adams, were instructed by the Board to represent the County Commissioners at the hearing.

Mr. B. Kennedy Abell, addressed the Board in behalf of Dr. H. Ross Coppage, requesting that the road leading from the Porto Bello Road to Carthagena Creek, be taken over by the County, in order that the County Relief Clients could be to improve this road.

The Board unanimously rejected the proposition.

Miss Lettie M. Dent requested the Board to grant the use of Grand Jury Room for sewing classes to be organized by for relief clients.

The Board granted this request of Miss Dent's.

The Board instructed the Clerk to write Mr. B. Kennedy Abell of the St. Mary's County Wellfare Board, that the Supervisors of Elections Office in the Court House, was available as headquarters for the St. Mary's Co. Wellfare Board. This being done to save the taxpayers of St, Mary's County the rent and heat bills now being paid by the County.
