Minutes of last two meetings read and adopted.

The Board accepted the Deed for Right of Way of section of road in Ist. District, from E. L. Ridgwell and others, and agreed to recommend its improvement.

The Board authorized the installation of phone in the office of the County Agent.

Letters from the local and Charles County Welfare Board, asking County Commissioners of St. Mary's Co, to approve the return of Alton Thompson and family, now in Charles Co., to St. Mary's Co. The Board refused to authorize the return of these people.

Mr. Tuckerman and Mr. Ridgley of Point Lookout Development Co. again addressed the Board and asked their approval of the Mosquito Control Project at Point Lookout, which has been previously discussed before the Board.

The Board took the following action on this matter, that is Resolved

That the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Md. approves and recommends the project for mosquito control in the Point Lookout- Tanners Creek Area, as outlined by the Bureau of Entomology of the University of Maryland, the work to be done with Federal and State Funds and labor, and that the Board desires that the project be carried through to completion, but without obligation of any kind on the part of St. Mary's County to complete or contribute to the cost of said project if for any reason work thereon should be discontinued.

The Board instructed the Clerk to Write Mr. Abel Wolman State Engineer of P.W.A., recommending as additional projects from St. Mary's County, the construction of side walk from the end of the Town Limits of Leonardtown to Leonard Hall School entrance, a distance of about 500 ft. and the construction of a walk from the jail in Leonardtown, to intercept the present walk to the Court House, a distance of 100 ft., and also a n apron across the front of the jail. The walks to be of Concrete, and to conform with the present walks.
