

Board Meeting

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Messrs Philip Dorsey, Sam O'Sullivan, & Gilbert Dent appeared before the Board and stated the County Assessment of the property of Major Davidson was too high, and requested the Board to reduce the assessment.

The Board promised to give this matter proper consideration.

Mr. & Mrs C.F. Willoughby requested the Board to take over and recommend the improvement of road to Stewarts Packing Plant, .9 of a mile. Mr. D.W. Coppage requested the Board to recommend the improvement of St. Mary's River Road from Flat Iron to Porto Bello Gate. The Board promised to look into both of these projects.

Mr. Bernard Burch and Mr. A.E. Meredith requested the Board to appropriate towards the construction of a pipe line to provide water for fire protection at Mechanicsville. After conferring with the Attorney to the Board of County Commissioners, the Board decided they had no authority to contribute or appropriate funds for this purpose.

Miss Bartoll and Miss Willie Greenwell, representing the Health Department, requested the Board to pay \$40.00 for xray pictures to be taken of 8 children, now excluded from county schools, suspected of having tubercelosis. The Board ruled it had no authority to authorize this expenditure.

Mrs Addie C. Maddox, Register of Will, requested the Board to defray the cost of painting the Register of Will's Office. The Board requested an estimate of cost, and promised futher consideration.

Mr. Joe Chaney, and Mr. Marshall Dent of the State Roads Commission visited the Board, and discussed the road programe for the present year.
