Mr. Jas. F. Combs and Jas. A. Bean requested the Board to recommend the completion of 1/2 mile gap in State Road from Great Mills to Indian Bridge. The Board explained the recommendations to the State Roads Commission for this fiscal year had been made, but promised to have this gap completed as soon as possible.

Captain Walter Cheseldine presented the Board with Deed and Plat of Survey of section of road from near Joe Baileys store to River Springs Post Office. The Board accepted the Deed and Plat, and same are filed in with the records of this office. (See Note at bottom of this page)

Mr. Leonard Alvey presented petition, asking the Board to take over and recommend the improvement of section of road from the Parran Connelys property towards Greenbrier, in the 3rd. Dist, and about 1/4 Mile long.

Mr. Alvey was advisee that Deed for Right of Way, and survey would have to be prepared and given to the county, And when this was done the Board would try to have this road improved, although it was very doubtful if any work could be done this year. Mr. Alvey also requested that his assessment be reduced on Greenbrier Farm. Mr. Adams was instructed to look into the matter.

The estimate of John Maddox to paint the Office of Register of Wills, in the amount of \$13.00 total cost, was accepted, and work authorized.
