Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Mr. D. W. Coppage requested Board to recommend the repair of West St. Mary's River Road, $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles between Great Mills and Porto Bello Hill. Mr. B. W. Thompson & Wm. P. O'Brien requested Board to take over and recommend the improvement of .42 mile of road leading into White Point Sub-division., in 3rd. District. The Board agreed to take over this section of road after Deed for Right of Way and Survey have been turned over to County Com.

Messrs Jno. R. Drury and C. Benedict Greenwell, interviewed the Board in regards to insurance on Court House and Jail. The Board agreed to place \$4000.00 insurance on Jail, and an additional \$4,200.00 on Court House. Both Policies embracing the Co- Insurance feature, and the rate to be .33cts. per hundred, and for a term of 5 years.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Commission, advising the said Commission that the following roads have been taken over as a part of the County Road System of St. Mary's County, and recommending that the State Roads Commission improve the within mentioned roads, The Deeds of Right of Way and Plat of Surveys have been conveyed to the County Com. and filed with records of this office.
