Minutes of last meeting read and adopted.
Captain Luther Miles, Messrs Geo. R. Quirk, Herman Coppage, Matthew Trimble and W.B. Fenwick, requested the Board not to sell Millstone Landing to Mr. Geo. A. Weschler, Mr. Weschler having requested the Board to sell the said landing to him at the last meeting of the Board, April 9th.

Having heard the protest of the above mentioned gentlemen, the Board unanimously decided not to sell the landing.

Miss Lettie Marshall Dent, Messrs Jno. W. Jones, and Mr. Johnson Canter, requested the Board to take some action to the end that the Roads leading to Hickory Hill and River Springs Schools, be improved. The Board promised to interview Mr. Chaney in an effort to have these roads improved.

Messrs Jno. W. Jones, Jos. M. Mattingly, and Johnson Canter of the County Welfare Board, requested the County Commissioners to continue paying rent for the Welfare Boards Office in Richardson Building until June 1st, 1935, at which time a reorganization of the Welfare activities in the County will be effected. This request was granted by the Board of Co. Com.

The Board unanimously decided not to allow County Pensions to any one now receiving aid from the County Welfare Board, or until after June 1st. 1935, when the policy of the Federal Emergency Relief and Old Ages Pension is better understood. The Clerk was instructed to check with the Welfare Boards Records, to determine those on the County Pension List, now receiving aid from the Welfare Board.

Mrs. Wm. E. Owens requested the Board to send her son, Richley Owens to Mercy Hospital for an operation, as a County Patient. The Board agreed to try to make arrangements with Mercy Hospital for this operation.
