Minutes of last meeting read and adopted.

Dr. Howard D. Lewis, & Mr. H. B. Burch, requested the Board to condemn .4mile of road through Mr. Lee McKays property, in order that the road leading too Dr. Lewis' & Mr. Burch's property could be taken over as a County Road and improved. Dr. Lewis and Mr. Burch agreed to pay for land and all cost of condemnation proceedings. The Board decided to visit the road in question June 4th.1935.

A delegation of ladies , headed by Mrs Aubrey Gardiner, requested the Board to make an appropriation for salary and expenses of the Home Demonstration Agent. These ladies heartily endorsed the work of the Home Demonstration Agent.

Miss Elizabeth G. Smith and Mrs Wilmer Matthews, interviewed the Board in reference to the Old Age Pension Law. The Board authorized the Welfare Board to make a survey of this county to determine the number of old people eligible for the benefits of this law.

Mr. Jump of the Firm of Elmer L. Hatter, Public Accountants, visited the Board, and was authorized to make an audit of the Books of the County Commissioners Office.

The Board reviewed the assessment made by Mr. Adams, on the property of Major Davidson, in the 5th. District, and approved the assessment.

Plat and Deed of Right of Way from W.G. Meredith, J. Eugene Cecil, & G. Leonard Cecil , to section of road leading from near Callaway towards Geo. Armsworthy's farm , presented to Board and accepted by the Board. The Clerk was instructed to notify the State Roads Commission, that this road is accepted as a part of the County Road System, and recommend its improvement. See letter on file to that effect.

Letter from Mr. Harry Richardson, regards to condition of road in St. Jeromes Neck read to Board. Clerk instructed to write ~~###~~ Mr. Joe Chaney, recommending improvement of this road this summer. See letter on file to that effect.

Clerk instructed to write Governor Nice, and the Board of Public Works to determine if any funds ~~were~~ available for transportation of High School Children for Scholastic Year Sept 1935-June 1936. See letter on file.
