Miss Fannie Joe Dent, requested the Board to decide a dispute as to whether the Bound Oak Landing on the property of the Dent Family at Oakley, is a Public Landing. The Board decided that the question was not within the jurisdiction of this Court.

Mr. Bernard Burch, Mechanicsville, requested the Board to contribute a sum of money for the construction of a pipe line, in Mechanicsville, for the use of the Fire Department. The Board agreed to appropriate \$200.00 for that purpose.

Mr. Gasparovic and other citizens of Great Mills, petitioned the Board to take action with the State Roads Commission, in an effort to relieve future storm damage at Great Mills, in their opinion caused by tall fill and insufficient bridge span on the Indian Bridge Road.
