Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Proposal of Mr. A. S. Jump, Public Accountant, to audit the records of the County Commissioners' Office, for the sum of \$200.00 accepted, and clerk instructed to advise Mr. Jump accordingly.

Mr. Horace Bowling and Mr. Kenneth Webb of the State Roads Commission requested the Board to recommend that any funds of St. Mary's County in charge of the State Roads Commission, for New Construction, and in excess of the amount required to complete the Three Notch Road, be transferred to the County Roads Maintenance Fund. See Letter on file to State Roads Commission.

Father Rudtker requested Board to take up with State Roads Commission the repair of Dynard to Cross Roads, road, See letter to Mr. Chaney on file.

The Board agreed to sell to Ben Owens, the old flooring removed from Alms House at 1¢ per ft.

The Clerk was instructed to have inserted in both County Papers the following Notice to Dog Owners.-

"  
On or before the 1st. Day of July, the owner of any dog or dogs, six months old or older, shall secure a license for each such dog. Any person violating or refusing to comply with the provisions of this law, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine or imprisonment# or both. Dog tags are now available at the office of the County Treasurer. June 1st. a Special Officer will be appointed in each District to collect# said licenses, and enforce the provisions of the law."

The Board reviewed the informstion furnished by the Local Welfare Board, pertaining to those on General Public Assistance. The Board decided to discontinue giving aid in 12 cases, and reduced the amounts previously given by the Welfare Board in 15 other cases.

The Clerk was directed to transfer ##### \$388.21 from the Commissioners General Fund, and set up a General Public Assistance Fund, to provide for those on relief, pending receipt of funds from State Comptroller.
