The Board agreed to pay the Special Officers 25 cts. for each tag sold and in the event of any dog owner refusing to purchase tag, the Special Officer is to receive 25 cts for each such case reported to the Board.

The Clerk was instructed to insert a notice in both County Papers advising the Public of the appointment of the Special Officers.

The Board approved the account of the Board of Education for High School Transportation for the year 1935-1936, in the amount of \$3,720.00, and ordered same included in the 1936 Levy.

The Board approved the request of the Welfare Board for an appropriation for the Needy Blind of the County in the amount of \$750.00, and ordered same included in the 1936 Levy.
