

Board Met June 23 1936

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.

Col. W. G. Fay, requested Board to recommend improvement of mile of road from Beauvue -Valley Lee Road to Route 5. Clerk directed to write State Roads Commission, recommending improvement of same. (See Letter)

Mrs Abell and Miss Neoma Wilkinson requested Board to recommend the improvement of Road from St. John's to Wilkinsons Store.

Miss Lettie Dent, Superintendent of Schools requested Board to providee for an increase $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ in teachers salary. Also requested Board to allow \$500.00 for improvement and repair of Schools.

The Board refused to grant the increase in salaries, but allowed \$300.00 in the 1936 Levy for School Repairs.

The Board authorized the building of a tool shed in connection with the present wood shed.

County Treasurer presented ~~#####~~ 1931 Insolvency List in the amount \$2,923.35, and 1932 Insolvency List in the amount of \$2,513.57, and asked same be allowed and provided for in 1936 Levy.

The Board dis-allowed the Insolvencies for 1931 and 1932 pending futher information.
