The Board met in special session to make a final check of un-licensed dogs.

Having done this the Special Officers previously appointed, were given instructions by the Board as to procedure in the cases of dog owners who have not purchased tags.

Each officer was given a list of the untagged dogs in his district, and directed to make a last call on the owners of these dogs, and to give him a final opportunity to purchase tag for the usual price. In the event of any one refusing to purchase tag, the special officer after having been sworn in as a constable, is to get a warrant from a magistrate & serve the warrant on the delinquent. From this point on the case takes the same status as any other ~~criminal~~ ^{CIVIL} case tried before a magistrate.

The Board agreed to allow the Special Officers .50 cents for each investigation made, and in cases where a warrant is served, the special officer is to get usual constables fee of .75 to be paid by the delinquent as a part of the costs imposed by the magistrate.
