

Board met Nov. 10th. 1936

Minutes last meeting read and adopted.  
Mrs Francis Gray, Dynard, Joe Bush, Leonardtown, Nace Joy, Hollywood,  
and Mrs Julia Hoffman, Charlotte Hall, requested aid from G.P.A. Funds.  
The Board refused to grant assistance in the first three cases and  
held the Hoffman case over for futher consideration.

Mrs Willie Howard of the Health Department, requested Board to grant  
\$10.00 for transportation of the 6 partially blind children of  
Henry Collins, Bushwood, Md, to Baltimore to attend the Wilmer Clinic  
for examination. Board acted favorably upon this request.

Mrs. Leonard Thompson, Charlotte Hall, again visited the Board and  
urgently requested that she be given \$10.00 for an operation on her  
child. Board granted the request.

In the matter of the claims of Louis Garner and Luther Copsey for  
damages to poultry, said claims being held over from the last meeting,  
the Board questioned Mr. Garner and the appraisers, in his case and Mr.  
Copsey and the appraisers in his case as well as Mr. Davis the Magistrate  
in the Copsey claim. After due deliberation the claims were adjusted.

The Clerk was directed to write all Magistrates, calling their attention  
to the duty of the Magistrate in the matter of executing claims for  
damages caused by dogs, and to advise said magistrates that unless  
flagrant irregularities, now being practiced by some of the magistrates  
are not stopped, steps will be taken to have magistrates guilty of  
such irregularities removed form office.

In the matter of compensation to Mr. Paul Greenwell, for injuries  
received while working on the Great Mills School, action on which  
matter was deferred from last meeting of Board, Mr. King, Atty. to  
Board rendered an opinion that the County Commissioners had no  
responsibility in the matter.

Clerk directed to advise Sheriff to kill dogs belonging to Lou Carter &  
Jno. S. Bean, of Beachville, and Corbett Bennett of California, said  
dogs having killed turkeys in the adjacent sections.

Clerk directed to write Carroll Alvey and Leopold Letspeich, of Charlotte  
Hall to attend the Board meeting N.v. 24th.
