

Board met at 10.30 A.M. June, 25, 1940

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.
Jno. H. T. Briscoe, Atty. For Geo. A. Weschler and Mr. Weschler appeared before the Board in reference to the Public Landing at Millstone on the Patuxent River and a proposed County wharf on this Public Landing. They claimed that the boundaries of this Landing as established by survey by Geo. W. Joy, Jr. are incorrect. Mr. Weschler offered to deed to the County a strip of Beach farther west from the existing Landing in exchange for the the present Public Landing and to pay any reasonable difference that the Commissioners might feel was fair in the exchange of properties. Mr. Weschler also offered to lease his wharf to the County for three years, without charge, The County to repair and maintain the wharf at County expense. After inspecting the present Public Landing, the strip of beach Mr. Weschler proposed to exchange and his wharf, and after hearing all interested parties who appeared before it the Board unanimously decided that it would not accept Mr. Weschler's offer, but would proceed to build ~~in~~ a County wharf at Millstone as originally planned. The Board decided that it would have a new survey of the Public Landing made.

Mrs Grason asked that the Board allow the use of the above mentioned Public Landing for a bathing beach for colored people. No action taken.
Miss Lettie M. Dent appeared before the Board in reference to the question of Colored School Teachers salaries, and also requested the Board to take over ~~the~~ and maintain the driveways to public schools, as public roads. The Board took no further action about the Colored Teachers salaries, and informed Miss Dent that the question of the driveways to schools would be looked into to see what could be done.

The Clerk was instructed to Notify the Comptroller that Senator Philip H. Dorsey is authorized to check the State income tax returns from St. Mary's County for this Board.

The Board fixed the salary of the Substitute Trial Magistrate and Clerk to the Magistrate Court at \$500.00 pyear. And the salary of the assist. Clerk and Baliff in this Court at \$400.00 per year. Both to be effective from July, 1, 1940. *Both payable monthly.*

The Board accepted Right-of-way deed from Jno. H. T. Briscoe for a road through his farm to a development on the Patuxent River, about .6 mile 6th Dist., and agreed to make it a part of the County road system, for maintenance only.

John Edwards Jr. requested the Board to accept into the County road system the road from the end of the present county road to Point Lookout Creek, about .8 mile, 1st Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Edwards or Mr. Robt. Hewlett.

A delegation composed of Mrs A. C. McKenney, Harry Hoke, Mrs L. M. Heagy, Mrs E. B. Haas, E. B. Haas, E. E. Goodrich, and Mrs Goodrich, W. W. Schamblin, Mrs Schamblin, Mrs Albert Morgan, Mrs Charles O'Brien, Harry Raley, Dr. M. S. Fealy, Requested the Board to have a bulkhead built at Scotland Beach to prevent erosion, and to accept into the County road system and construct a road, ~~at~~ from Scotland Beach Hotel towards Point Lookout, about .25 mile, 1st Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report, and the Clerk was instructed to write the State Roads Com. for information regarding Bulkhead.

Wm. A. Herbert and James Purcell asked for G. P. A. Mr. Johnson will take these cases up with the Welfare Board. Louise Chase requested the Board to provide money for the repair of her artificial leg. Mrs. Burch will take this case up with the Vocational Rehabilitation Service and see if they will help in this case.
