Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. Wm. Fenwick and Mr. Alec. Loker, representing the Commissioners of Leonardtown informed the Board that no funds had been received from the State Roads Commission by the Town for the 1939-1940 fiscal year. They asked the Board to request the S.R.C. pay over to the Town \$250.00 from the County road funds. The Board agreed to do this and instructed the Clerk to take the necessary steps to have the funds paid over.

The St. Mary's Co. Welfare Board called the Boards attention to the case of Beatrice Briscoe formerly from the 1st Dist. this County, but a resident of the State of New York for more than 5 years. The New York Welfare Authorities claiming that since she was on relief when she became of age she could not legally become a citizen of New York and that she should be returned to St. Mary's County. The Board declined to accept her as a public charge on the ground that she had been a resident of New York too long.

Mrs. Jos. F. Crew, Garrett Cheseldine and Samuel Bailey requested the Board to accept into the County road system the road running from the State road leading to Capt. Mat Baileys to Mr. Garrett Cheseldine's, about .5 mile, 7th Dist. They claimed this road would serve 8 taxpayers. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mrs. Crew.

The Board accepted Survey and Right-of-way deed for a road from the end of the State road from Wynne P.O. to the 3 Notch road, about 498.5 ft, 1st Dist. The Clerk was instructed to request the State Roads Commission to accept this road into the County System and improve same.
