Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Miss Lettie Marshall Dent, Superintendent of Schools inquired of the Board if anything could be done about having some gravel hauled for repairing the approaches to certain public schools. Mr Johnson will see if this can be done.

On the certificates of Dr. F.A. Camalier and Dr F.F. Greenwell the Board committed Mitchell Hill to Crowns ville State Hospital, as of Nov, 17, 1940; and on the Certificates of Dr. L.B. Johnson and Dr. F.A. Camalier, the Board committed Eliza Forbes to Crownsville State Hospital as of Nov, 16, 1940.

Ray H. Couleman and Benj. Tippett, saying that they represented most of th interested parties, asked the Board the Board to accept into the County road system the 3 Notch Point road, about 1.25 miles, 8th Dist. for maintenance only. Mr. E.A. Norris and H.C. Duckson opposed this plan and asked the Board to accept into the County road system and build a new road through Mr. Norris's property to 3 Notch Point, about 1.5 miles 8th Dist. The Board decided to make a personal inspection of the two propositions before making a decision.

Mr. J.F. Bradburn, Mr. Raley, Leo Trossback, Louis Trossback and L.E. Trossback, again asked the Board to accept into the County road system for maintenance only the road from the St. Jerome's Neck road to Mr. Leo Trossback's Place, about 1 mile, 1st Dist. They also caimed that due to a stopped up Culvert some of their land was beeing flooded by rains and asked that this condition be remedied. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Bradburn.

William Butler asked the Board to pay Hospital bill of Chas. Butler at La Plata and James Mason at Casualty Hospital, Washington, both being St. Mary's County residents, the Board could see no reason why the family could not pay their own bills, and refused to pay above bills.

The Board granted Luke Gray G.P.A. of \$10.00 to help him save his crop, he having recently undergone a serious operation and having to funds to hire help with.
