Minutes of preceeding meeting read and approved.

Mrs Bart Frayer and her 6th and 7th grade children were allowed to observe the proceedings of the Board.

The Board granted William Nash the privilege of staying at the Alms House for the Winter.

On the certificates of Dr. Leslie B. Hohman and Dr. Rachel B. Brass the Board committed Lillian Owens to Spring Grove State Hospital, as of Nov, 22, 1940.

Dr. F. F. Greenwell, Medical Examiner, recommended to the Board that the present law applying to the work of the Medical Examiners be amended to provide that in the Counties, any sudden death not attended by any suspicious circumstances would be handled by the family Physician as in the case of other deaths. And that in cases the Medical Examiner had to handle, that the sheriff or his Deputy should attend with power to summons witnesses who would be required to give testimony before the Examiner.

J. E. Brown, Leslie Cryer and Arthur Williams requested the Board to accept into the County Road system road leading from Compton to Delehays to Mr. Arthur Williams place on Combs Creek, about 1.0 mile, 3rd. Dist. They claim will serve 8 families. (for maintenance only) Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Brown.

Mr. Richley Brown again requested the board to accept the road from the Glebe State Road to Forrest Farm about 1.25 miles, 3rd. dist. Mr. Thompson again asked to report on this road.

Mr. Thompson also requested to make such temporary repairs as may be needed to the Frogs Marsa road, 2nd. dist.

Miss. Harriet Reeder asked the Board to provide some assistance for Ada Holt, about 87 years old, and unable to do any work. Board granted \$10.00 per month G.P.A. Board also granted \$10.00 G.P.A. to Luke Gray to help him finish saving his crop, and to get fire-wood.
