Being a special meeting the minutes were not read. The Board decided to abandon a section of the road bed of the old 3 Notch County road which was not used by the State in building the new 3 Notch road and which adjoins the property of Wm. A. Lantz, 8th Dist. and also to abandon a section of the old Piney Point County road bed, <sup>2nd Dist</sup> between Valley Lee and Tall Timbers and which adjoins the property of B.M. Springer, and was not used by the State in constructing new Piney Point road, 2nd Dist.

The Clerk was instructed to notify Mr. Springer and Mr. Lantz of the above action.

The Board discussed the question of transportation of children attending non State aided schools with Mr. Paul J. Bailey, Atty. to the Board of Education, with a view to having the Board of Education take over the transportation of all school children. Mr. Bailey consulted with Miss Lettie M. Dent, Super of County schools on the matter. Miss Dent felt that the local Board of Education could not do this without special permission from the State Superintendent of schools.

The Board decided to ask its Atty., Hon Philip H. Dorsey, to arrange for a meeting of this Board with Dr. Albert S. Cook, State Super. of schools, for the purpose of considering just what can be done, in the matter of transporting children to non State aided schools.
