Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved:

Mr. J. P. Connolly requested the Board to sell him the Public Land at Foxwell's Point, 3rd Dist. for the purpose of building home on it. The Board decided it would not sell any Public Landings at this time.

Dr. L. B. Johnson, President and R. Bascom Broun, Cashier of the First Nat. Bank of St. Mary's appeared before the Board to explain the reason why the Bank had refused to handle some County Scrip that was recently received by the Bank. They said the Board of Directors of the Bank had since unanimously voted that it would not only accept County Scrip but would be glad to have all that was presented to it.

The Clerk was instructed to notify the 1st Nat. Bank of its intention to withdraw the several "Time Open accounts" in the Bank for use in meeting the debt service. the accounts in question being the following: "St. Mary's Co. Road Fund; Sinking Fund of St. Mary's Co., Road Bonds, acts 1920; and Sinking Fund St. Mary's Co. Lateral Bonds, acts 1924."

The Clerk was instructed to Write the ~~XXXX~~ State Dept. of Public Welfare That the Board recommends the appointment of States Atty C. Henry Camalier as Atty to the Welfare Board.

Clerk was instructed to have the Sheriff get an estimate of cost of a fence around the Jail.

In response to a letter from the Commissioners of Leonardtown requesting the appointment of two Constables for Leonardtown. The Board decided that it would not appoint any Constables as the present law requires that Constables be paid asalary.

Commissioner Combs reported a culvert on the Mill Hill road, 8th Dist. as being in a dangerous condition. Mr. Thompson asked to see to this. Mr. H. P. Daugherty and Mr. R. H. Couleman presented a petetion signed by eight interested parties asking the County Commissioners to condemn a right-of-way through the land of Mr. Enoch Norris for a road from the 3 Notch road towards 3 Notch Point, 8th Dist. The signers also pledging themselves to pay two thirds of the cost of Condemnation. Mr Norris have refused to grant a right-of-way. Mr Daugherty and Mr Couleman also asked road to be accepted into the Couny system be extended to the 2nd fork of the road. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to Contact Mr. Johnson the Commissioners having decided on a personal investigation.

Mr. A. B. Lawrence requested that the County accept into the County Road system for maintenance about 300 yds of road as an extension of the presad road running from Abell towards Canoe Neck Creek. Mr Thompson asked to report. And to contact Mr. Lawrence.

Father McKenna asked that the St. Peter Clever road, about .77 miles, 1st Dist. be improved.

Mr. Chas. W. Huseman Reported to the Board that MR. Webb had promised him that if he would allow the county to drain the water from the County road beyond Abell's P.O., 7th Dist. through his land that Mr. Webb would have his private road repaired for him, and that this has not been done. Mr. Thompson asked to look into the matter.
