Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

The Board again considered the question of Walter Baker, now a patient in Spring Grove State Hospital, after a 21 year term in the Maryland Penitentiary, where he was sentenced by the Prince George County Court in 1920. The Hospital claiming that he was a legal resident of St. Mary's County at the time of his conviction he is now properly a charge against the County. After having the Registration books of the 6th Dist examined back to the Year of 1914, and finding nothing to support the claim that he was a citizen of the County, the Board again refused to accept responsibility for Baker's maintenance at the Hospital; but the Clerk was instructed to request the Superintendent of County schools to have the old ~~School~~ rolls of schools in the 6th District examined to see if they would throw any light on the question.

The Clerk was instructed to write the State Employment Commissioner and recommend the appointment of Samuel Hill as a ~~laborer~~ laborer on either the State or County roads, he having been refused employment because he is past 50 years old, and Mr. Johnson being personally aware of Mr. Hill's ability and willingness to perform the work that would be required of him. The Clerk was also instructed to send a copy of the letter to the Director of Personnel, State Roads Commission.
