Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Capt. P.A. Gotton requested information about bidding on the proposed new jail. No information could be furnished as the project still lacks approval by the War Production Board.

The Board ordered that the Salary of the Baliff for the Trial Magistrate Court be increased to \$600.00 per year because of the extra to be done during the present emergency. Increase to be effective as of Dec, 1, 1942

Miss Lettie M. Dent, Superintendent of Schools explained to the Board that she was about to prepare plans for applying for Federal Funds for new school facilities to provide for the large number of children brought into the County by War workers.

The Board decided that Mr. W. Paul Cecil would be the County Commissioner who would serve on the St. Mary's County Welfare Board for the present year.

The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Andrew T. Conner, State Milage Conservation Administrator that since the County owns no Motor Vehicles It could see no reason for appointing an Administrator for this County.

The Clerk was instructed to hold the January checks for salary to C. Henry Camalier until the deed for tax sale property to Grace J. Hughes had been recorded. He having accepted the money for writing and recording this deed in September 1941 but has never completed the transaction.

Mrs Carrie L. Morgan and Mr. J. Spieth, represented by Jos. D. Weiner, Atty. asked the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, road running from the Leonardtown-Hollywood State road at Thomas Swalles place north about 1/2 mile, 3rd Dist. they claimed that Aubrey Graves and Lucius Swalles would also be benefitted by the road. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mrs Morgan or Mr. Speith.

Mr. J. W. Norris, Jr. asked the Board to accept into the County road system, for maintenance, about 1 1/2 miles on the Glebe end of the St. John's-Glebe road, 3rd Dist. Mr. Thompson asked to report and to contact Mr. Norris. Mr Norris claimed that Phil Russell, Elmer Guy and the Bennetts would also be benefitted by this road.
