Minutes of preceding regular meeting and Special meeting, May, 31, 1943, *read* and approved.

C. Henry Camalier, States Atty. asked the Board to provide funds for the purpose of getting assistance from either the Baltimore City or the State Police Vice Squads in obtaining evidence against certain Establishments in St. Mary's County suspected of being vice centers, and against which places there has been much complaint; but because ~~the~~ our local officers are known they are unable to obtain sufficient evidence against these places to secure a conviction. The Board instructed the Clerk to issue a C.G.F. check payable to Howard V. Hammett, Sheriff, for the above purpose, in the amount of \$100.00.

The Clerk was also intructed to issue a C.G.F. check to Harry P. Wise, J.P. for \$25.00 for extra work as J.P. for the year ending April, 30, 1943, and fixed Mr. Wise's compensation as J.P. at \$100.00 per year Commencing May, 1, 1943.

The Board authorized the President to arrange with and employ <sup>either</sup> Mr. Mace Birch, St. Inigoes, Md. ~~and~~ Jack Bean, Callaway, Md. as special Agents of the Board to issue and collect for Trailer Licenses, each Agent to give a Corporate Bond in the amount of \$2000.00 in favor of The County Commissioners of St. Mary's County; the compensation of ~~these~~ agents to be 10% of all money collected and also 10% of all fines paid by violators, Trailer law (Chapter 973, Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1943 Session) who had been prosecuted by such Agent. The Board also ordered that ~~these~~ Agents report ~~to~~ and turn in all money collected for Trailer License on Tuesday of each week to the Clerk to the County Commissioners.

The Board instructed its Attorney to notify Mr. John Mudd, Attorney for the Complainants, that unless all costs in the School Bus Law trial are paid by July, 15, 1943 execution would be issued for the collection of same.

The Clerk was instructed to try to arrange with the Board of Education for a joint meeting with ~~this~~ Board on June, 22, 1943 at 2.30 P.M. for the purpose of discussing the problem of transporting school children.

On the certificates of Dr. Francis F. Greenwell and Dr. Frank A. Camalier the Board committed Mary E. Willis to Crownsville State Hospital as of May, 27, 1943.

The Board appointed the following as special Officers to issue dog licenses: Mace Birch, 1st Dist.; Jack Bean, 2nd & 19th Districts; Jas. A. Latham, 3rd, 4th & 7th Districts; Thos. B. Brookbank, 4th Dist.; Robt. S. Burroughs, 5th Dist.; Ollie Moran, 6th Dist.; Allan Sydnor, 7th Dist.; Harry P. Wise, 8th Dist. Their compensation to be 25¢ for each license issued, and also the same for any license issued by the Treasurer in his territory provided the Officer turns in the license number as proof that he has called on the dog owner. The Clerk was instructed to publish notices in all the local Newspapers giving the names of the officers from whom licenses can be obtained and notifying dog owners that unless they license their dogs on or before July, 31, 1943 they will be prosecuted for violation of the law.
