Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mr. Philip H. Dorsey, Jr., and Mr. John Cooper representing Mr. Frank Brady and Mr. Barry Keogh and other property owners of Scotland Beach appeared before the Board and urged that a right-of-way through the property of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Morgan to a number of cottages, that have had no outlet since the old State road was washed away several years ago, be condemned. After consultation with Mr. Joseph Chaney by phone, it was agreed that Mr. Chaney and Mr. M. C. Thompson, Jr. would go at once and try and get Mr. and Mrs. Morgan to agree to grant a right-of-way for a reasonable price and that if these negotiations failed, the clerk is instructed to write the State Roads Commission and request that the Commission institute condemnation proceedings to obtain this right-of-way.

Mr. J. Julius Johnson, heading a committee of farmers and also presenting a list of 15 farmers requesting that the Board approve and request the allotment of 40 war prisoners from the camp in Charles County for the purpose of aiding the farmers in saving their crops. The Board approved and instructed the clerk to write Dr. T. B. Symons, Director of Extension Service, University of Maryland, and request his aid in securing labor to save the crops in the County and to suggest to that war prisoners would be a satisfactory solution of the problem if they can be obtained.

Clerk instructed to write the C. & P. Telephone Co. about cost of maintaining a fire alarm system for the Lexington Park Fire Dept.

The Board arranged with the Dean Lumber and Supply Co. to furnish aluminum paint for the Court House roof and white paint for the windows, delivery to be made by Monday, August 14th.

Bernard L. Goldsborough asked the Board to sell him from the Alms House Farm, 2 acres of land at the corner of # 5 highway and the Medley's Neck road.

Paul Bell asked the Board to sell him 2 acres of land from the Alms House on the east side of # 5 highway. Pending investigation by Mr. W. Paul Cecil, the Board took no action on either request.

Mr. Chesley reported the "James" road, 5th District, to be in very bad shape and asked that something be done to improve it.

Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Curtis asked that something be done to provide a better roadway on the "Planes" road, 5th District, claiming the road is almost impassable at times.

Mr. Thompson asked to give these roads attention just as soon as possible.
