

OCTOBER 3rd, 1944

SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board met at 11 a.m. Present W. Paul Cecil, Pres.
John E. Guy
Elmer R. Jarboe.

This special meeting was called for the purpose of conferring with Mr. George Lawrence re reassessment of property of First and Ninth Districts, and to consult with Mr. Marye about renegotiating contracts on new jail, and to view property, as Board has agreed to transfer to Messrs. Paul Bell and Thomas Ridgell from Alms House Farm

Mr. George Lawrence outlined procedure he considers should be followed in notifying property owners as regards their assessments.

Mrs. Boony Wood and her son, tenants on Green Hills Farm reported road in bad condition. Clerk to advise Mr. Thompson of this complaint.

Mr. and Mrs. Ivar Olson registered complaint re road leading to Blackistone Farm from the Clarke Landing Road. Mr. Thompson advised, and he informs that machine was there when they were before the Board.

Dr. J. Bay Jacobs requests that his private road be taken care of when the Roads crew works on highway adjacent his farm. He expressed desire to defray expense. Consulted Mr. Thompson on the matter, who informs that under orders road crew may not perform for private parties. Advised Dr. Jacobs of order.

Board visited Alms House; viewed the acreage to be transferred to Messrs. Paul Bell and Thomas Ridgell. Decided that in this case and for any other acreage to be sold from the Alms House Farm that \$100.00 per acre will be price. The Bell and Ridgell negotiations to be concluded at regular meeting.

The Board surveyed the surroundings of the Court House and the new jail and considered means of ingress and egress and parking problems incident to the use of property when jail is occupied. Also the question of storage of fuel for the winter. The sewerage problem was also discussed.
