A telegram from Governor O'Connor inviting the Board to attend a meeting of County Commissioners at the State House, Annapolis, at 2P.M. Friday, February 25th, 1944, was received. It was decided that Commissioner W. Paul Cecil and Commissioner Elmer R. Jarboe and Atty. Philip H. Dorsey Jr. would attend this meeting.

Mr. Benj. F. Owens asked the Board to sell him one or two acres of land from the Alms House farm on #5 State Highway. No action taken by the Board. The Clerk was instructed to write the F.W.A., Richmond, Va. and inform them that the question of deeding the land needed for the new jail had been referred to it's attorney for an opinion and the opinion would be forwarded to them as soon as it is ready.

There was considerable discussion of the Teachers Bonus and Transportation of School children. No action taken by the Board.

Board appointed Joseph S. Cusic Watchman and Maintenance Officer for Court House and fixed his salary at \$80.00 per month commencing as of February 1, 1944.
