Resolved By the Board of Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Md., no extensions of existing bus routes will be granted for any distance of one-half mile or less.

Request from Naval Chaplain for letter from Board to Comm. Officer at N.A.T.S. Base, Patuxent River, in re; co-operation with Naval authorities at Base in transportation of children on base to ALL SCHOOLS and request letter from Comm. Officer at Base assuring Board of Co. Comm a like cooperation if they are in a position to pick up any children not residing on base.

Following letter addressed to Comm. Officer NATC., Patuxent River, Md.

"The Board of County Commissioners propose to co-operate with authorities at the NATC, Patuxent River, in transportation of children from the base to schools outside the reservation. The Board requests the assurance to the County Commissioners of like co-operation in the transportation of children they might be in a position to pick up and transport to the County Schools, if not inconveniencing the NATC Transportation Schedule.
