EXTRACT FROM MINUTES of

BOARD OF EDUCATION

Tuesday, December 14, 1948

The Board of Education recognizes the dire need for improved school buildings in St. Mary's County, and realizes that St. Mary's County cannot finance this building program without increased aid from the State. The Board therefore adopts the following Resolution and requests that copy of same be delivered to the County Commissioners and to each person representing St. Mary's County in our General Assembly.

RESOLVED: --- That the Board of Education of St. Mary's County recommends that the present Building Incentive Fund participation rate be at least tripled and that efforts be made to secure necessary legislation to this effect.
