Bd. of Education- Payment of School site in Ltn.

The Board of Education appeared relative to the \$2,000.00 check to Mr. J.M.Mattingly, Sr., deposit on school site in Ltn. Commissioners advised the Bd. Educa. should hand the check to Mr. Mattingly and that Atty P.J.Bailey for the Bd. Educa. and Atty J.H.T.Briscoe, atty for the Bd. Co. Com. confer with reference to the further payment of the site from funds secured through the State School Aid program. Land is being surveyed and will cost \$1,000 per acre. Mr. Briscoe felt a better price could have been obtained had he and someone else approached Mr. Mattingly. Mr. Claude Johnson advised that he and Mr. Geo. Thomas visited Mr. Mattingly and the first price for the land was \$1250.00 per A. Later Mr. Mattingly agreed to sell the entire plot for the sum of \$1,000 per acre. Tract is to be surveyed, it is estimated that it is 18 Acres. Miss Dent informed that the amount already received through State Aid- or asked thru State Aid- is allocated to 5th Dist. Elementary and Bannaker Consol. In view of the fact that the site in Leonardtown is in the corporate limits, with fire, water, sewage, lights and police protection it is well worth purchasing and holding for the school.

The Board adjourned at noon.
