W.S. Donaldson and B.H. Sterling, auditors, having completed the 1950 audit of County Commissioners' and Treasurer's books, Mr. Donaldson presented the audit and explained it at length. The books of Clerk to the Circuit Court and Trial Magistrate which are also to be audited by these auditors will be done after July 1st, at the close of their fiscal year. Donaldson and Sterling were awarded the audit for 1951, Jan 1 to June 30 inclusive of Commissioners' and Treasurer's books, which will then put these two offices on the fiscal year base July 1 to June 30 as are all other offices in the Court House and County government. The 1951 audit is for \$800.00

Zoning violations at Lex. Pk  
Atty Arthur Rysticke with Mr. Ed King appeared relative to alleged violations of the law by Mr. King. Mr. King lives in a one-family dwelling in the Park. He recently made some renovations in his house which permits a family to occupy the 2nd floor. This is in violation of the Park Zoning laws, but was done due to the housing shortage in that area. The Bd. referred the matter to the Zoning Bd which was meeting that afternoon.

Federal Aid for new Health Center  
Dr. A.D. Houser presented forms to be used in securing Federal Aid for the new Health Center project. These were filled out, signed and handed to Dr. Houser. A Resolution, asking for this aid appears in these minutes, signed by the entire Bd. Copies were given Dr. Houser for the State Health and Federal Health Depts.

McKay's Beach Road  
Mr. Bernard McKay headed a delegation from McKay's Beach section asking that the road there be repaired. DEED for R of W was recorded in 1940 for 30 ft road road will be repaired.

Fire Dept-McKay's Beach  
The delegation advised they are planning to have a Vol Fire Dept and asked for specifications regarding same in order to receive County aid. There are none, except the fire company must be active, then they can receive not over \$700 per year, from the County.
