Complains that in 2 years taxes were raised from \$2475 to \$3655 that they are paying for acreage they do not own.  
Decision- have property surveyed, and if they are overcharged adjustment will be made but the assessment is fair.

2-Camp Maria- asks that camp be exempt- Mr. Sterling read Law's 1950-page 3902 Chap 27- camp not used solely for educational purposes and is not exempt. Ask that bill for the Camp be sent separately from that of the Academy.

3- Elizabeth & Bernard Somerville-Loveville  
desires to know just how assessment was made- explained and she was satisfied

4- Mrs. Emily Raley Vause- satisfied about assessment asks that name be changed from Raley to Vause

5- Ernest Moore- Ltn represented by JHT Briscoe- property very badly constructed- down stairs rented as beer garden upstairs not usable, Decision keep assessment at \$2,000

5- Mrs. Walter Clements- Ltn asks that assessment be reduced as property is in bad condition inside. Outside looks good and decision was to allow assessment which Bd. feels is low.

6- H.K.Stettler- Compton. asked for explanation as to how assessment was reached and satisfied when informed.

7- Ruth and Marcene Rausch- R2 Leonardtown  
1.7A building in bad shape but large, and house was cubed and at 15¢ Bd feels it is fair price- Decision, assessment remains as is.

8- Edwin B & Josephine Floyd- Compton  
misunderstood assessment-thought it was being added to their old assessment- satisfied when informed what had been done.

The Board adjourned at noon.
