All Board members and their attorney were present today.

#### Roads.

Gen. Hume Peabody, Compton, Md., asked that repairs be made on the road leading to Rose Bank Farms. Over 6 years ago Mr. W.S. Knight deeded 40 ft. R of W to the County- serves 19 families thruout the year, with 10-12 additional families during the summer. Several new homes now being constructed there. Board will consider the matter.

#### Boss Bailey Road.

Delegation asked that road be oiled, this is an old road used by school busses etc. Board will check on same and make recommendations.

#### Bus Service

Delegation from Bay View Trailer Camp asked that bus be allowed to continue down the Green Holly road to pick up several children whose parents now bring them by car to the highway. Driver is said to come into road and back out- also the road is constantly used and children endangered while walking to bus. Board will check the road etc., and make recommendations.

Delegation from Lexington Park are asked that parents be allowed to pay for seats in the busses for children, thus assuring those who ride in crowded busses that they will always have a seat. Attorney advised this would be illegal and cannot be done.

#### Grand Jury

The members of the Grand Jury, Mr. Henry Burroughs foreman, visited the County Commissioners' office, asked for explanation of their work and looked over the ledger after being informed how entries etc., were made. They sent in their report which has been filed.

H.T. Waring & Son, Insurance Agents were requested to prepare the proper papers to cover all employees of the County with accident insurance. This does not cover bus drivers who are under contract as private individuals.

Clerk was instructed to write a letter to Shrf. W.B. Long instructing him to remove all unlicensed machines which appear on the sidewalk in Lexington Park, since the owner of the machines- Chris Novelty Co of Baltimore were advised by letter in June-53 to remove the machines within ten days or same would be confiscated.

#### Bus Route Extensions;

Mr. Alvey, Mr. Stone, Paul Bell and M.R. and J.L. Dean were to meet on Wednesday morning and traverse the bus routes from Red Gate to and thru Center Gardens and decide which contractors

would handle the extensions needed in that area.

Paul Bell extension of 52 miles per day, plus 4 miles in Medley's Neck was granted. This will add \$2,016.00 per yr or \$168.00 per mo to his contract.
