Regular meeting was held today with full board in attendance.

Chimney Sweep bid \$70.00 to clean the 3 chimneys on County owned property CH-J-AH No decision made until it is determined whether chimneys need cleaning.

Clerk instructed to order supply cabinet for Supvrs. of Assessments office.

Fresh Pond Neck Road Capt Will Clarke and Srgt called about this road. .6 mi 8 houses Board agreed to put road on 55 program- is between Bradburn's & Wilkinsons'

St. Mary's County Mem. Lib. asked to have road leading from town on both sides of Health Dept repaired-in very bad condition. Board desires R of W from Turdor Park Co for this road

Plumber-

Dr. Robt Locke, sanitarian for the County Health Dept called to talk about a Plumbing Inspector for the county. Plumbing is being done by others than registered plumbers and all work is not satisfactory from a sanitary standpoint. Colored houses in Lexington Park opposite Dock and Gateway were served notice April 1, to tie into pipe landssewer lines and clean up their places and abandon use of central well and privet now in use. Desires Board to enforce this notice. Board will consider the matter. Feels there should be a Plumbing Code and Pl. inspector.

Rosecroft Road. 2.2ml petition signed by 14 families to have road conditioned. Trees grow so close to the road that for a space of 200 yards there is not sufficient room for 2 cars to pass. Mr. Thompson said the road should be reconstructed entirely and asked that SSRC be requested to place this road on the 1955 list. SRC will try to have So.Md.Elec.Co meet them and cut down trees. Taxpayers on the road will remove the trees .

Piney Point Shores- Mr. Herman Babbel asked that road serving 13 families be repaired- Mr. Stone and Mr. Thompson will inspect the road and report at next meeting.

B.W.Poindexter consulted Board about Civil Defense employees for Central Alarm System- 3 will be paid \$2100 per annum and 1 will be paid 2700 per annum. desires to have sick leave 30 days per annum and reg. leave of 15 days, to place them on retirement fund-or social security feels all fire Depts send in their recommendations and County Commissioners have final authority to select employees. Board will meet with Civ. Def amd County CFD April 28 in Conference room, County Bldg.

Eagle Construction Co-phone call from Mr. Ed Hellman requesting Tax Bills for 53 and 54. Letter to Mr. Hellman, letter to Irving Trust Co of NY concerning this matter. In files.

Letter to Eagle Construction Co advising them it is now seasonable weather for black topping road. Board agreed Construction Co should do this- letter in files.

Clarke's Landing Road- was inspected but no definite action

Wharf at Smith's Creek- Bid from S.T.Foxwell, \$1195.00 pulling down old wharf, furnishing and driving piles for new wharf- accepted
