The Commissioners and their attorney met in regular session today.

#### Board of Health

At 10 a.m. the Commissioners met as the County Board of Health with Dr. A.D.Houser, secretary. Dr. Robt. Locke, sanitarian was also present. Vital health conditions affecting the County were under discussion. 1. 14 new cases of T.B. have been reported so far this year. 2. Sewage conditions in the County must be improved and people educated to the use of septic tanks Plumbing and Building Inspectors are needed and one inspector might be found who could fill both positions. Change in price of Bldg permits discussed-this needs new law. After July 1 no licenses will be issued to jack-leg lumbers- notice to this effect to be prepared and published in both County papers. Dr. Houser will prepare the notice. Dr. Locke was asked to sell dog tags there is an extra fee of \$1 attached to each tag sold after Aug 1st. In view of the number of dogs roaming about untagged the Bd. agreed to pay the extra \$1 now for each tag sold.

#### G.Mills-Lex.Pk Road asks for Water and Sewage

W.M.Loker, Jr., attorney, representing 35 taxpayers who reside along this road, presented a petition signed by them asking for the water and sewage. This would serve the homes, 2 schools and all the trailers in this area. Project would cost approximately \$100,000 USNATC has been contacted and they inform that their disposal system is not working to capacity and Navy could easily take care of the waste. Mr. Sterling asked to become familiar with the law and Commissioners will discuss this matter at a later meeting. SRC is now laying new road and it would be well to install pipes etc., for this project before road is completed, if the Commissioners decide to take the matter up. Mr. Loker will be advised if and when a decision has been reached.

#### Swimming Pool-Shirley K Hotel

Copy of letter and petition signed by property owners in this area who feel the water supply will be lowered and St. Patrik's Creek contaminated if this is allowed. Letter and petition were addressed to the Dept. Geology, Mines and Water Resources protesting the granting of this request. Commissioners also wrote the above Dept for an expression of their opinion in the matter.

A survey of this road is to be made-Mrs. Miller reports it has not been done- Boundary line in question was established in 1888 when verbal R of W was granted. Board will take other measures if Mr. VanWard fails to allow survey.

Old Fort Lincoln at Pt Lookout

Mr. Thompson suggests this would make ideal picnic area-would need lots of work, landscaping etc., but would be beautiful. Commissioners also feel it would be good picnic area No definite action taken.
