

June 5, 1956

At the regular meeting held today all members and their attorney were present.

A group of colored parents from the several sections of the County called with reference to transportation of their children to parochial schools. Those present were Martha Jones, Alice Thomas, Estelle Collins, Margaret Fenwick and Mr and Mrs Louis Groves. The schools in which they desire their children to enter are St. John's, Sacred Heart, Holy Angels and Fr Andrew White. It was their hope they said to iron out some of the difficulties presented by the letter which was read in the Catholic churches in this County several weeks ago, when it was announced that colored children who would attend 1st and 2nd grade would be eligible to enroll in the white parochial schools of this county. Mr. Alvey explained that Fr. Wilkinson was in charge of transportation to these schools, appointed by the Archbishop- and they should contact him. Whatever recommendations made to the Commissioners by Fr Wilkinson in this matter will be given consideration by the Commissioners.

Miss Dent came in and there was a discussion on the integration question. Requests for the \$221,000 State School Loan, balance available for this County, were signed. This money will be used for Ridge-Margaret Brent-Banneker and Hollywood.

A letter received from Mrs Christian, secretary to the Hollywood Methodist Church requesting lights in front of the church was answered, that at this time the request could not be granted.

Sewage at Great Mills- Jos A Mattingly attorney for a group of residents of the Great Mills area where the question of sewage is being considered, asked if the Commissioners would advance the cost of the survey for that project. A long discussion followed, but the Commissioners did not grant this request.

Clerk was requested to contact Fr. Wilkinson for special appointment in Washington-this was done he will phone the date.

Meeting adjourned at 4 p.m.
