Board and attorney met this morning.

Miss Dent appeared to explain the request for \$844,000.00 school loan. It is necessary to request whatever amount the Bd desires from the June Bond issue, and they signed a request for \$50,000.00. The breakdown is as follows

Miss Dent explained that while Jarboesville has been presented to the Fed Govt for funds, it will need supplementary local funds. Both Leonardtown and Banneker 1-12 grades, are overcrowded and using class rooms in substandard buildings which are not part of the main school plant. A Fed fund school at Towne Creek 6 cr and multi purpose room has been asked for from Fed. Govt \$275,400.

James Ford, 2013 37th St SE Wash-20-DC came in about a road to his place on St Geo Isl. it is near a Public landing Mr. Thompson will check this land, and if found convenient to have a Public Landing there, the County will locate a road but it will be necessary for the property owners in that area to agree to give land for R of W- and follow the usual procedure before the County can accept the road.

The Building Committee meet with the Board at 2:30 pm and discussed with Mr. Tilp various subjects pertinent to the completing of the building. In the matter of the County Seal above the porch in the tympanum, it was finally decided to contact Eddie Stokel, Jr and ask for a price to have the seal painted on, instead of the 3 dimension seal as hitherto planned by Mr. Tilp which it is estimated will be expensive. Bids are to be secured from Paul Co and Ted Nuskowicz for the Court room Judges benches and also Treasurer's counter. Judges benches are in such bad condition it will cost almost as much to repair them as to make a new one.
