Paul Bell, busses overcrowded, 90 MILES added to his route, new bus to be ordered, contract was \$4,000.00 per year. He will advise when he receives new bus and \$300 will be given him for bus.

Dr. Houser and Dr. Locke came in about trash piles in the 8th Elec. District. Sheridan Fahenstock wants to be arrested for violating State law about dumping trash, want to make this a test case.

George Clarke asked Mr. Sterling milk situation as far as schools are concerned here. Dr. Houser advised that the State Law definitely requires milk be served in ~~apt~~ containers or bulk, and only the State Health Dept can authorize a change. *milk dispensers*

Mrs. Chas. Knott- Oakley want road thru the Lacey property to her farm. Roads from Dynard to Hurry if R of W across field can be secured road will be be less than 1 mi. Mr. Alvey with Mr. Guy will check on this and see if practical to build and if R of W can be obtained.

Douglas Bond to check Dr. Johnsons road which is in bad condition, also Town Creek road where it washed out

Paul Bell complained that when his bus comes down from Camp Calvert to R5, there is a hill and cars coming up cannot see the bus and this prevents him turning safely onto the highway. He asks for a sign at that intersection of the R5 to Camp Calvert.

Mr. Bowman is to lay off a plat for Pegg Road, Mr. Bond will check with him on this.
