Dr. Locke came in about the unsanitary condition of the Willows Road. Mr. McLeod gave price of \$100 to \$150 to clean up the entire road. Mr. Alvey feels owners should then be notified to keep their property clean. Want SRC signs "No Dumping" placed along this area-will get signs from SRC before cleaning road.

Mr. Alvey would like to see Capt Lee about making Dump site on the Streckland swamp land. Letter to Capt Lee asking if he can come in Oct 15 at 3 pm to go see the land.

SRC advises that on Sept 17 at a Committee meeting they Resolved to place signs at Chaptico-Mech road, SRC 234 with advance sign notifying cars of stop sign ahead. Dr. Boyd was notified of this.

Lexington Park Rescue Squad appeared and asked for assistance, they cover the County for ambulance cases at no charge- non-profit organization of 8-10 members who leave their work when called upon. Not a part of the Lex Pk Vol Fire Dept but work with it. Part of Civil Defense organization Have \$1000 note to meet Jan 1, and insurance of \$350. Carroll D. son, M. Davis, Ben Johnson and Robert Gunter. Bd. will considr matter and advise them.

Clerk authorized to have all broken chairs repaired-if they are good enough for it.

Bldg Com met at 3 pm to inspect the Court House. Several minor items need attention and will be fixed.

Douglas Bond ^{to assist if} asked ~~to have~~ SRC ^{draw} up plans for repairs at Tall Timbers seawall so Board can advertize for bids on this work.

Miss Dent came in to ask that rooms vacated by County Agents and staff be repainted and display boards be removed from walls. Says floor needs attention Mr. Alvey to see rooms on Wed and decide what needs to be done.

Colored County Agent to be advised that room at head of stairs is set aside for him-will be painted etc. Met Victor Mears and advised him of this and he with staff from Colored County Agent's office at Carver Hts inspected the room.
